Health Care; revises eligibility categories for optional Medicaid services; restricts certain nursing, intermediate care, or state mental hospital services to extent that Medicaid contract beds are available; eliminates Medicaid coverage for adult denture services; limits coverage for hearing & visual services to children under age 21; revises eligibility for pharmaceutical expense assistance program, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 01/01/2002 except as otherwise provided.
