Tax Relief/Residence/Tropical System; provides for reimbursement of portion of ad valorem tax levied on house or other residential building if building is rendered uninhabitable due to named tropical system; provides for reimbursement of state sales tax paid on purchase of mobile home to replace mobile home that experienced major damage from named tropical system; requires that application for such reimbursement be made with property appraiser; provides application requirements, etc. Appropriation: \$35,070,000.

Effective Date: Upon becoming law.
