Just Valuation of Real Property/Highest & Best Use; Deletes a requirement that property appraisers consider the highest and best use of property as a factor in arriving at just valuation. Requires property appraisers to use only the income factor in arriving at just value of income-producing properties, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.
