Research Funded by Pari-mutuel Wagering; Deletes provisions for certain moneys to be used for research relating to the medication of racing animals. Deletes provisions relating to the Pharmacokinetic and Clearance Study Agreement by and between the DBPR Pari-mutuel Wagering Division and the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine. Repeals provisions relating to research and development programs funded by moneys in the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

H 5011-C GENERAL BILL by Policy & Budget Council; Mayfield (Compare CS/2ND ENG/S 0022-C)

Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; Requires that all female cattle vaccinated with the Brucella abortus vaccine be identified according to federal regulations. Repeals provision relating to the purchase, distribution, and administration of the approved brucella vaccine. Amends provision relating to gift certificates and credit memos, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.
