From the Eastern District, Hon. John Warren, Hon. William J. Mills, and Hon. Isaiah D. Hart.

On motion of Mr. Dupont, seconded by Mr. Berthelot, the Hon. John Warren was called to the chair.

On motion of Mr. Berthelot, seconded by Mr. Dupont, it was Resolved, There being no quorum present, that the Senate stand adjourned until to-motrow, 12 o'clock.

Tuesday, January Stn. 1839.
