Journal of the Senate of the 13th General Assembly of the State of Florida, begun and held at the Capitol, in the City of Tallahassee, on Monday, the twenty-first day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.

MONDAY, November 21, 1864.

This being the day fixed for the meeting of the General Assembly of the State of Florida, the Senate met at 12 m.

On motion, Hon. A. K. Allison, Senator from the 7th District, was called to the chair.
