

# EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

## JOURNAL OF THE SENATE

Monday, June 11, 1945

The Senate convened at 1:00 o'clock P. M. pursuant to adjournment on Thursday, June 7, 1945.

### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

By Senator Coleman (13th Dist.)—

S. B. No. 7-X—A bill to be entitled An Act to apportion the representation of the State of Florida in the Senate of the State of Florida.

Which was read the first time by title only.

Senator Coleman (13th Dist.) moved that the rules be waived and Senate Bill No. 7-X be placed on the Calendar of Bills on Second Reading, without reference.

Which was agreed to by a two-thirds vote and it was so ordered.

### SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### HOUSE BILLS ON SECOND READING

House Bill No. 2-X was taken up in its order and read by title for the information of the Senate, having been read the second time by title only on Thursday, June 7, 1945, and placed on the Calendar of Bills on Third Reading.

Senator Gray moved that the Senate do now adjourn.
