EXPLANATION OF ARRANGEMENT OF INDEX

MEMBERS OF SENATE, INDEX. Here will be found the name of each Senator, the District which he represents, the Bills, Memorials, etc. he introduced or was co-introducer with one or more other Senators, and the committees on which he served.

MISCELLANEOUS SUBJECTS IN THE SENATE. From this it will be possible to locate in the Journal such things as Committee reports, Governor's communications to Senate, Messages from House of Representatives, Executive Session Announcements, Roll Call of Members, Senate Rules, etc.

NUMERICAL LIST OF 1947 VETOED BILLS. This gives the location in the Journal of where these Bills were considered and either the veto upheld or the Bill was passed over the veto.

ALPHABETICAL INDEX OF SENATE BILLS, MEMORIALS, ETC. The title of each is indexed in an alphabetical arrangement, using topics or catch words related closely to the subject matter and therefore it will be easy to find the Senate number of any Bill, Memorial, etc., by tracing several words which either describe or are closely connected to the subject matter sought.

NUMERICAL INDEX OF SENATE BILLS, MEMORIALS, ETC. Here will be found a list of each piece of legislation introduced in the Senate, set up in numerical order according to its duly designated and assigned **Senate number**, followed by a brief explanation of the subject matter and then a list of all pages in the Journal on which it appears. By using the designated Senate number and the page numbers which follow, it is possible to trace the entire progress from introduction to passage, step by step.

NUMERICAL INDEX OF HOUSE BILLS, MEMORIALS, ETC. Here will be found a list, set up in numerical order by its duly designated and assigned **House number**, each piece of legislation originally introduced in the House of Representatives and which finally reached the Senate for its consideration (missing numbers failed to reach the Senate and died in the House). Each number will be followed by a brief explanation of the subject matter and a list showing all page numbers in the Senate Journal on which it appears.
