## INTRODUCTION

By Senators Stone and Saylor—

SM 73—A memorial to the Congress of the United States

to provide for amending the United States tax laws so as to rebate and pay to each of the states an amount equal to one half (½) of the federal taxes collected on alcoholic beverages and tobacco sold within such state.

Was read the first time in full and referred to the Committees on Apportionment, Resolutions and Memorials; and Finance and Taxation.

By Senators Thomas, Spencer, Weissenborn, Griffin and Bell—

SB 74—A bill to be entitled An act relating to electronic technicians, regulatory board; defining certain words and phrases; requiring persons rendering or offering service for a fee or gratuity to be licensed; creating a Florida electronic technicians examining board; providing for its membership, qualifications, powers and duties; providing requirements for applicants before issuance of license; providing for revocation, fees, appeal from orders; providing penalty; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Governmental Reorganization and Judiciary "A".

By Senators Stolzenburg and Bell—

SB 75—A bill to be entitled An act relating to harness horse racing permittees amending Florida statutes 550.069 and providing for the payment of a fixed daily license fee in lieu of the payment of taxes by such harness horse race track where the average daily pari-mutuel pool is less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) per day; repealing all laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act and fixing the effective date of this act.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Ethics and Privileged Businesses; and Finance and Taxation.

By Senators Hollahan, Askew, Friday and Weissenborn—

SB 76—A bill to be entitled An act creating and establishing a legislative bill drafting department; providing for an advisory committee; providing for personnel and for a legislative library; fixing the powers, obligations and duties of the department; providing an appropriation; and fixing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators Hollahan and Poston—

SB 77—A bill to be entitled An act relating to building codes; amending section 125.56(4), Florida Statutes, to direct building and zoning departments to require the recording and posting of notices of commencement or recommencement.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Judiciary "A"; and Urban Affairs and Local Government.

By Senator Spencer—

SB 78—A bill to be entitled An act relating to public schools, compulsory attendance, minimum age; amending chapter 65-398, Laws of Florida, omitting exemptions therefrom; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Education—Public Schools and Junior Colleges.

By Senator Spencer—

SB 79—A bill to be entitled An act relating to public schools, compulsory attendance; amending section 232.01, Florida Statutes; removing therefrom certain exemptions; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Education—Public Schools and Junior Colleges.

By Senators Spencer, Shevin, Poston, Gong, Fincher, Hollahan, Stone, Knopke, Thomas and Weissenborn—

SB 80—A bill to be entitled An act establishing minimum

wages in Florida; excluding certain establishments; providing by regulation for employment of handicapped workers, learners and apprentices; providing enforcement powers; providing remedies for employees; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Labor and Industry; and Judiciary "A".

By Senators Shevin, Weissenborn, Fincher, Spencer, Poston, Gong, Haverfield and Saylor—

SB 81—A bill to be entitled An act relating to taxes on gasoline and like products; amending section 208.44(3), (12), Florida Statutes, changing the distribution formula for seventh (7th) cent tax; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Public Roads and Highways; and Finance and Taxation.

By Senators Shevin, Hollahan, Fincher, Stone, Poston and Gong—

SB 82—A bill to be entitled An act relating to bonds for material witnesses to insure their appearance at trial; amending chapter 903, Florida Statutes, by adding section 903.011, which provides that material witnesses in a criminal prosecution post a bond in a good and sufficient amount, in accordance with the general provisions of chapter 903, Florida Statutes, to insure their appearance at trial; providing that the trial court may except therefrom witnesses who, in its discretion, need not so indemnify their appearance; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senators Shevin, Hollahan, Fincher, Poston, Stone, Gong and Weissenborn—

SB 83—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the intimidation of witnesses subpoenaed before a grand jury, trial court or before a prosecuting official; amending chapter 836, Florida Statutes, by adding section 836.051, which provides that one who either verbally or by written communication or by physical act coerces, threatens or puts in fear another who is to appear as a witness before a grand jury, trial court or prosecuting officer with intent to compel the person so intimidated or any other person to do any act or refrain from doing any act against his will; making such intimidation a felony; providing a penalty; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senators Shevin, Young and Weissenborn—

SB 84—A bill to be entitled An act relating to duties, functions and powers of patrol officers, amending section 321.05, Florida Statutes, repealing all laws in conflict herewith and providing the effective date hereof.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Transportation and Safety; and Judiciary "B".

By Senators Gunter and Friday—

SB 85—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the district courts of appeal, judges; amending section 35.06, Florida Statutes, providing for additional judges for the fourth (4th) district; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senator Poston—

SB 86—A bill to be entitled An act relating to operation of railroads; amending Chapter 351, Florida Statutes, by adding Section 351.31, to provide that the Boards of County Commissioners may regulate the speed of railroad trains in certain areas; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Urban Affairs and Local Government; Transportation and Safety; and Judiciary "A".

By permission, Senator Poston withdrew SB 87 from the Senate.

On motion by Senator Edwards, by two-thirds vote, SB 56 was withdrawn from the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By permission, Senator Edwards withdrew SB 56 from the Senate.

By Senator Poston—

SB 88—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the county road systems; providing for improvements thereof through employment of professionally trained county engineers and minimum standards for construction and maintenance; providing additional funds therefor; and providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Public Roads and Highways; and Urban Affairs and Local Government.

Senator Broxson presiding.

By Senator Poston—

SCR 89—A concurrent resolution directing the legislative council to make a study of administrative appeals; providing for appointment of a study committee; and providing for the payment of expenses.

Was read the first time in full and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senator Poston—

SB 90—A bill to be entitled An act related to statutes of limitations; amending subsection 95.11 (1) and (3); providing a five year limitation on actions founded upon an instrument of writing; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senator Poston—

SB 91—A bill to be entitled An act relating to rule making under the administrative procedure act; amending subsection (3) of section 120.041, Florida Statutes, relating to the filing and taking effect of rules; providing for adoption of rules at public meetings of state agencies after notice to interested parties; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senator Poston—

SB 92—A bill to be entitled An act relating to outdoor advertising; amending chapter 479, Florida Statutes by adding section 479.23, excluding erection of signs incidental to other improvements from chapter 479, Florida Statutes; and amending section 479.16(1) defining certain exceptions to chapter 479, Florida Statutes; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Public Roads and Highways; and Judiciary "A".

By Senator Poston—

SB 93—A bill to be entitled An act relating to insurance; amending subsections (3) and (6) of section 627.101, subsection (3) of section 627.111, subsection (1) of section 627.141, subsection (1) of section 627.151, subsection (3) of section 627.181, subsection (3) of section 627.201 and subsection (3) of section 627.211, Florida Statutes, providing for the approval or disapproval of rate filings by the insurance commissioner; giving the insurance commissioner the power to modify rate filings; providing the effect and effective date of modification of rate filings; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

By Senator Poston—

SB 94—A bill to be entitled An act relating to workmen's compensation; amend- paragraph (g) of subsection (4) of section 440.49 Florida Statutes, providing for reimbursement of an employer for a subsequent injury; providing that the method of reimbursement and presumption in the proceeding; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Labor and Industry; Insurance; and Judiciary "A".

By Senator Poston—

SB 95—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the state board of health; amending section 381.011, Florida Statutes, providing for the composition of the board; expanding the number of members of the board to nine; providing the qualifications of members of the board; providing for appointment of members of the board and the filling of vacancies on the board; providing for election of president of the board; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health and Welfare; and Governmental Reorganization.

By Senator Poston—

SB 96—A bill to be entitled An act relating to workmen's compensation; amending subsection (3) and (4) of section 440.39; providing for the division of proceeds of a recovery from a third person between the employee and the employer or carrier; providing a method of computing the division of the proceeds; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Labor and Industry; Insurance; and Judiciary "A".

By Senator Poston—

SCR 97—A concurrent resolution directing the legislative council to continue a study of the construction industry and to make recommendations for coordinating the activities of the various segments of the construction industry; authorizing the establishment of a select committee and appointment of members; authorizing the establishment of advisory committees; requiring a report be made to the 1969 legislature; providing for the payment of expenses of committee members.

Was read the first time in full and referred to the Committees on Labor and Industry; and Rules and Calendar.

By Senator Poston—

SB 98—A bill to be entitled An act relating to workmen's compensation; amending paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 440.25, providing for procedure in respect to claims; prescribing the method and scope of review of fact findings of deputy commissioners; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary "B".

By Senators Fincher, Hollahan, Sayler and Henderson—

SB 99—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the milk commission, abolishment; repealing chapter 501, Florida Statutes, abolishing the milk commission.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Livestock; and Governmental Reorganization.

By Senators Fincher and Hollahan—

SB 100—A bill to be entitled An act relating to outdoor recreation and conservation; amending section 375.021(3), Florida Statutes, defining the responsibility of the outdoor recreational development council in reviewing the comprehensive outdoor recreational development plan for the state prepared by the outdoor recreational planning committee; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Governmental Reorganization.

By Senators Weissenborn, Stone, Shevin, Haverfield, Poston and Fincher—

SB 101—A bill to be entitled An act relating to state employment, discrimination; providing that no state agency, board, commission, department or state official shall refuse to hire any individual because of race, color, religious creed, or national origin; providing aggrieved individual with a hearing and judicial review; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Labor and Industry; Governmental Reorganization; and Judiciary "A".

By Senator Deeb—

SB 102—A bill to be entitled An act relating to banks and

trust companies; amending section 659.06, Florida Statutes, by removing the restriction for providing for branch banking houses; amending chapter 659, Florida Statutes, by adding new section 659.061, providing that a state bank or trust company having its principal banking house in any county may seek authority to establish a branch or branches in such county; providing for approval by commissioner; providing that no branch shall be authorized outside of county in which principal banking house of the state bank or trust company is located; providing that commissioner may issue rules and regulations governing establishment of a branch or branches; providing that authority granted to commissioner may as to national banks be exercised by appropriate federal supervising authority; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Banking, Securities and Loans.

SB 103—A bill to be entitled An act regulating the manufacture, dispensing, sale, prescription, administration, possession and use of certain drugs not regulated by the uniform narcotics drug law; amending certain sections of chapter 404, Florida Statutes; creating section 404.001, to change the name of chapter 404 to "Florida drug abuse law"; amending section 404.01, defining certain terms used in this chapter; amending section 404.02(1)-(3), (8), (10), relative to prohibited acts by limiting possession of specified prescribed drugs to those in containers in which delivered by seller or dispenser, by limiting refill authorization, requiring pharmacists to maintain files on prescriptions filled for hallucinogenic drugs, prohibiting certain deceitful and fraudulent acts in obtaining hallucinogenic drugs; repealing section 404.03, exempting certain drugs; amending section 404.04(2)(d), (f), limiting exemptions provided therein; amending section 404.05, relating to records; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health and Welfare; and Judiciary "B".

By Senators de la Parte, Hollahan and Thomas—

SB 104—A bill to be entitled An act relating to pharmacists, qualifications; amending section 465.071(2), (3), Florida Statutes, exempting citizenship requirements; providing certain educational qualifications; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health and Welfare; and Judiciary "A".

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 105—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Hillsborough county; providing for the combination of county water and sewer systems into a single consolidated system; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 105.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 106—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the city of Tampa, Hillsborough county, appeals from the municipal court; amending section 10, chapter 61-2924, Laws of Florida, by providing for enforcement and forfeiture of supersedeas bonds in such appeals; providing for entry of judgment on supersedeas bonds; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 106.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 107—A bill to be entitled An act relating to humane societies in all counties having a population of not less than three hundred ninety thousand (390,000) and not more than four hundred fifty thousand (450,000), according to the latest official decennial census; amending section 1 of chapter 61-1722, Laws of Florida; providing for a contractual arrangement between the board of county commissioners and humane societies

located and operating in such counties; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 107.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators Knopke, de la Parte, McClain and Ott—

SB 108—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the city of Temple Terrace; authorizing city to abate weeds, grass and underbrush as nuisances; providing for a lien for the cost to be placed on property involved; providing for written notice to the owner of property; providing for method of collection of liens.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 108.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 109—A bill to be entitled An act relating to appropriation of certain funds from the compensation of the clerks of the circuit courts and courts of record in all counties of the state having a population of not less than three hundred ninety thousand (390,000) and not more than four hundred fifty thousand (450,000), according to the latest official decennial census; amending sections 1, 4, 5, 7 and 8 of chapter 63-1047, Laws of Florida; providing sum to be charged by the clerk to parties instituting suit in circuit court, authorizing the board of county commissioners to appropriate sum to legal aid bureau; authorizing use of legal aid funds for legal aid bureau partially supported by federal funds and for a legal aid program coordinated with that of a legal aid bureau supported by federal funds; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 110—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Hillsborough county hospital and welfare board; amending section 9, chapter 63-1402, Laws of Florida, to provide that a member of the board of county commissioners of Hillsborough county other than the chairman may serve as a member of the hospital and welfare board of said county; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 110.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 111—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the city of Tampa, firemen and policemen pension fund; providing in certain instances that some members of said fund having served in the offices of the state attorney or county solicitor for Hillsborough county may have such period included in their creditable service determination for purposes of retirement benefits; providing effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 111.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 112—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the city of Tampa, Hillsborough county, pension; amending section 1 of chapter 26253, Laws of Florida, 1949, by increasing the amount of pension paid by said city to Dave King; repealing chapters 57-1892 and 63-1974, Laws of Florida; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 112.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 113—A bill to be entitled An act relating to bottle clubs in counties having a population of not less than three hundred and ninety thousand (390,000) and not more than four hundred and fifty thousand (450,000), according to the latest official decennial census; providing for a definition of the term bottle club; excluding restaurants from the act; requiring a license for operation; making bottle clubs subject to existing state and local laws regulating vendors of alcoholic beverages; providing for enforcement of the act; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 113.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 114—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Hillsborough county, construction of railroad tracks crossing public highways; requiring notification and permission of jurisdictions affected; providing effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 114.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 115—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the city of Tampa, Hillsborough county; requiring the state road department to submit plans and specifications for projects within the city limits to the city council for approval; authorizing the city council to withhold approval of any project not in accordance with the street, drainage and land use plans of the city; authorizing the city council to require inclusion of bordering drainage areas in the plans submitted; providing for the control of construction of borrow pits, borrow areas, drainage retention areas and retention lakes; declaring any project not approved by the city of Tampa to be a public nuisance; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 115.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 116—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Hillsborough county; repealing section 6, chapter 24592, Laws of Florida, 1947, which provides for a county zoning commission; providing effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 116.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 117—A bill to be entitled An act relating to civil service board members, political activity, in all counties having a population of not less than three hundred ninety thousand (390,000) and not more than four hundred fifty thousand (450,000), according to the latest official decennial census; prohibiting members of civil service boards of all cities having a population of more than two hundred fifty thousand (250,000), according to the latest official decennial census, from engaging in certain political activities; providing penalties for the violation thereof; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 118—A bill to be entitled An act relating to beverage licenses; authorizing issuance of licenses to the Hillsborough county aviation authority or other governmental agency operating Tampa international airport; providing that the number of licenses be limited; providing for application; providing for transfer; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 118.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.

By Senators de la Parte, McClain, Knopke and Ott—

SB 119—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Hillsborough county; authorizing the board of county commissioners to grant franchises to persons agreeing to furnish public services which the county is authorized by law to perform; providing for an annual franchise fee; providing for rules and regulations; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 119.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.
