INTRODUCTION

By the required Constitutional two-thirds vote of the Senate the following bill was admitted for introduction and consideration:

By Senator Mathews—

SB 55-X(68)—A bill to be entitled An act relating to public

printing; amending section 283.19, Florida statutes, to provide that the legislature shall pay as a legislative expense all items designated as class "A" printing; providing that the secretary of state shall be furnished with sufficient persons to serve as proofreaders for the content of pamphlet laws, general laws, and special acts; and providing an effective date retroactive to July 1, 1967; ratifying previous payments; and authorizing expenditure of revolving fund.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

By Senators de la Parte and Askew—

SB 56-X(68)—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Division of Corrections, academic and vocational training programs; appropriating funds from the general revenue fund; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Mental Health, Retardation and State Institutions; Education-Public Schools and Junior Colleges; and Appropriations.

MOTION RELATING TO COMMITTEE REFERENCES

On motion by Senator Boyd, by two-thirds vote, SJR 44-X(68) was withdrawn from the Committee on Education-Public Schools and Junior Colleges.
