SB 464—A bill to be entitled An act repealing section 811.15, Florida Statutes, providing penalty for second conviction for violation of section 811.14, Florida Statutes; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

SB 465—A bill to be entitled An act amending section 811.14, Florida Statutes, removing minimum penalty; providing alternative imprisonment in county jail or fine; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

By Senator Ott—

SB 466—A bill to be entitled An act relating to perjury; amending chapter 837, Florida Statutes; by adding sections 837.05, 837.06, and 837.07 thereto; providing that an indictment or information for perjury and kindred offenses need not set forth any part of the record or proceeding with which the oath was connected or any of the details relating to the oath or affirmation; providing that any information or indictment for perjury nor proof at trial need show which of two inconsistent statements is false; establishing the voluntary retraction of a false statement prior to its substantially affecting the proceedings as an affirmative defense; repealing section 906.16, Florida Statutes; providing an effective date.

SB 468—A bill to be entitled An act relating to liability insurance; amending chapter 627, Florida Statutes, by adding sections 627.0128 and 627.0129; providing for direct action against liability insurance companies by injured persons; providing that insolvency of the insured shall not release insurance company from liability; providing an effective date.

SB 469—A bill to be entitled An act relating to negligence actions; amending chapter 768, Florida Statutes, by adding section 768.061; providing that damages be awarded according to the comparative negligence principal.

SB 470—A bill to be entitled An act relating to child care facilities; providing for the regulation of child care facilities by the state board of health; providing for the adoption and enforcement of rules and regulations; providing for right of entry; providing for preservation of certain licensing laws; providing an effective date.

SB 471—A bill to be entitled An act relating to motor vehicle registration; amending section 320.10, Florida Statutes; providing for exemptions of certain state owned and operated motor vehicles; providing for tax exemption of motor vehicles owned and operated by The Waterfront Rescue Mission, Inc.; revising annual fee to conform with section 320.08 (11), Florida Statutes; providing an effective date.

SB 478—A bill to be entitled An act relating to wrecked and derelict property, defining abandoned property, establishing procedures cumulative to the provisions of Chapter 704, Florida Statutes, and amendments thereto, whereby counties may remove abandoned property from public and private property and destroy such abandoned property, providing penalty for obstructing enforcement of the act, granting immunity from prosecution to officers enforcing the act, and authorizing incorporated municipalities in the counties to adopt the act by reference; providing an effective date.

SB 479—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; adding subsection 253.12 (9), F. S.; providing that sections 253.111 and 253.12, F. S., shall not apply to, and no sale of state-owned submerged lands shall be allowed in, Sarasota county; providing an effective date.

- (g) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May.
- (h) Birthday of Jefferson Davis, June 3.
- (i) Independence Day, July 4.
- (j) Labor Day, the first Monday in September.
- (k) Columbus Day and Farmers' day, the second Monday in October.
- (l) Veterans' Day, the fourth Monday in October.
- (m) General Election Day.
- (n) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November.
- (o) Christmas Day, December 25.
- (p) Shrove Tuesday (sometimes also known as Mardi Gras), in counties where carnival associations are organized for the purpose of celebrating the same.

Section 2. Section 683.02, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 683.02 Meaning of term "legal holidays" as used in contracts.—[Wherever] *Whenever*, in contracts to be performed in the state, reference is made to "legal holidays," [legal holidays] *the term shall be understood to [be the following:] include those holidays designated in section 683.01, Florida Statutes, and such others as may be designated by law.*

[The first day of the week, Sunday; January 1, New year's day; January 19, birthday of Robert E. Lee; February 22, Washington's birthday; April 26, Memorial day; June 3, birthday of Jefferson Davis; July 4, Independence day; first Monday in September, Labor day; general election days; Thanksgiving day; December 25, Christmas day; Good Friday; October 12, Columbus day and Farmers day; November 11, Veterans' day; and also the day known as Shrove Tuesday, commonly known as Mardi Gras in counties where there may be a carnival association.]

Section 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 1971.
