

JOURNAL OF THE SENATE

Wednesday, April 8, 1970

The Senate was called to order by the President at 8:30 a.m. for the purpose of conducting the order of business of Introduction and reference of Resolutions, Memorials, Bills and Joint Resolutions, pursuant to Rule 4.3.

INTRODUCTION

By Senators Bell and Gong—

SB 504—A bill to be entitled An act relating to abuse of children; amending section 828.041, Florida Statutes, to provide for reports of child abuse from physicians, institutions, nurses, schoolteachers and social workers; itemizing considerations in reporting maltreatment; providing for central registries; providing immunity from liability; making violation a misdemeanor; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health, Welfare, and Institutions and Judiciary.

By Senator Bell—

SB 505—A bill to be entitled An act relating to public business; amending subsection (1) of section 286.011, Florida Statutes, renumbering subsections (2) and (3) and adding new subsections (2) and (3), providing exemptions from provisions of this act, providing for executive sessions, providing that portions of executive sessions not covered by exemptions shall be open to the public; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

By Senator Haverfield—

SB 506—A bill to be entitled An act relating to municipal firemen's pension trust fund; repealing section 175.041(2), Florida Statutes, which provides that the chapter does not apply to unincorporated areas or governmental entities whose employees are eligible for membership in a state or county retirement system; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By Senators Haverfield and Weissenborn—

SB 507—A bill to be entitled An act relating to taxation; levying an excise tax on the severance of all solid minerals, prescribing tax rate and manner of collection; creating pollution control device trust fund; authorizing the department of air and water pollution control to administer the use of funds collected for the assistance of public and private agencies; providing for enforcement; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Ways and Means.

By Senator Bishop—

SB 508—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the department of transportation; amending sections 334.04, 334.061, 334.062(2), (3) and (4), Florida Statutes, providing for creation of a department of transportation board, an executive secretary, and compensation for the board; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Transportation and Governmental Organization.

By Senator Thomas—

SB 509—A bill to be entitled An act relating to lease of municipal owned lands for nonpublic use; amending section 167.77(1), Florida Statutes, to require such lease only upon competitive bid; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

By Senator Thomas—

SB 510—A bill to be entitled An act relating to sale or lease of county property by county commissioners; amending section 125.35, Florida Statutes, to authorize lease of county real property on competitive bids; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

By Senator Thomas—

SB 511—A bill to be entitled An act relating to marine turtle eggs; repealing chapter 30112, Laws of Florida, 1955, and chapter 61-899, Laws of Florida, relating to an exemption for the taking of marine turtle eggs in counties having a population of not less than thirty thousand (30,000) and not more than thirty-two thousand (32,000) according to the latest official decennial census; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Rules and Calendar.

By Senator Johnson—

SB 512—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the state capitol; authorizing and instructing the department of general services under the supervision of the state fire marshal or his successors to make necessary improvements to the capitol to meet safety standards requirements as prescribed by the state fire marshal or his successors or local fire officials; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Rules and Calendar and Ways and Means.

By Senator Johnson—

SB 513—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the division of health, research aviaries; providing purpose, authorizing the division to establish and operate research aviaries in Indian River County; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health, Welfare, and Institutions and Ways and Means.

By Senator Johnson—

SB 514—A bill to be entitled An act relating to marriage counselors; requiring licensing of certain individuals who carry on the practice of marriage counseling in Florida for a fee, monetary or otherwise; providing definitions; creating a board to be known as the state board of marriage counselors within the department of professional and occupational regulation; prescribing the membership, duties, and powers of said board; providing for issuance and revocation of licenses; providing exceptions; fixing penalties for violation; providing funding; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Commerce and Licensed Businesses and Governmental Organization.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 515—A bill to be entitled An act relating to trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; amending section 253.122, F. S., to locate bulkhead lines at the line of mean high water; providing exception; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Judiciary.

By Senators Daniel and Trask—

SB 516—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the division of health; amending section 281.031 (1) (g) 3., Florida Statutes, to remove authority to regulate production, handling, and processing of food products; authorizing the division of health of the department of health and rehabilitative services to act in case of epidemics; amending section 381.071, Florida Statutes, relating to regulations of the division of health; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health, Welfare, and Institutions and Agriculture.

By Senator Scarborough—

SB 517—A bill to be entitled An act authorizing municipalities which own and operate stadiums wherein football games are played to impose, levy and collect taxes upon the right to admission to football games played at such stadiums in lieu of rental charges for the use thereof; providing for the collection and disposition of such taxes; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 518—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the board of trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; amending section 253.12(5), Florida Statutes, to provide that riparian upland owners shall consent before dredging may be done for a public purpose; defining riparian owner; providing exceptions to this act; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Judiciary.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 519—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the board of trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; amending section 253.123(2) and (4), Florida Statutes, to prevent removal of sand, rock, or earth from the navigable waters lying channelward of bulkhead lines; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Judiciary.

By Senator Wilson—

SB 520—A bill to be entitled An act relating to forestry; amending sections 589.28, 589.29, 589.30, 589.31, 589.32, 589.33 and 589.34, Florida Statutes; providing for cooperative forest management assistance; providing for assistance in urban environmental improvement through the use of trees; providing for cooperative agreements between the Florida board of forestry, counties or municipalities; providing for quality of assistance; defining duties of a district forester; providing for cooperative financing of assistance rendered; providing for expenditure of funds; providing effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Ways and Means.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 521—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the board of trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; amending

chapter 253, Florida Statutes, by adding section 253.132; providing for the registration of dredging equipment engaged in dredge and fill operations in and about the navigable waters of the state; providing a registration fee; requiring that a decal be displayed on registered equipment; prescribing violations; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Ways and Means.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 522—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the board of trustees of the internal improvement trust fund; amending section 253.02, Florida Statutes, by adding subsection (4) to provide the board of trustees with the power of eminent domain over submerged lands previously conveyed by it; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Judiciary.

By Senator Henderson—

SB 523—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the bureau of beaches and shores, coastal construction; amending chapter 161, Florida Statutes, by adding section 161.052; providing a setback line for coastal construction and excavation; providing for the granting of permits and approval of variances by the department of natural resources; authorizing more strict local requirements; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Judiciary.

By Senator Daniel—

SB 524—A bill to be entitled An act relating to harness tracks; amending section 550.37(4), Florida Statutes, requiring that closing dates be not later than June 1 of any year; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Licensed Businesses.

By Senators Daniel and Trask—

SB 525—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the division of hotels and restaurants of the department of business regulation, amending section 509.032, Florida Statutes, providing that the division of health shall perform inspection services relating to hotels and restaurants, providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Health, Welfare, and Institutions and Governmental Organization.

By Senators Daniel and Trask—

SB 526—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the department of agriculture and consumer services; amending section 502.012 (41), Florida Statutes, providing for definitions; amending section 502.171, Florida Statutes, providing that the enforcement of the provisions of Chapter 502, Florida Statutes, shall be vested in the commissioner of agriculture; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Health, Welfare, and Institutions.

By Senators Daniel and Trask—

SB 527—A bill to be entitled An act relating to factories, warehouses, establishments, vehicles or retail food outlets,

subject to the inspection provisions of chapter 500, Florida Statutes; amending chapter 500, Florida Statutes, by adding a new section to be known as section 500.211, Florida Statutes; providing for the issuance of permits by the department of agriculture and consumer services; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Health, Welfare, and Institutions.

By Senators Daniel and Trask—

SB 528—A bill to be entitled An act relating to foods, drugs and cosmetics; amending section 500.21, Florida Statutes; clarifying jurisdiction of commissioner of agriculture and division of health; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Health, Welfare, and Institutions.

By Senators Johnson and Saylor—

SB 529—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Florida Wing of the Civil Air Patrol; providing nonprofit educational status; providing an appropriation; authorizing certain expenditures; requiring a surety bond be furnished; providing an effective date.

Was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
