COMMITTEES

Interim (includes Commissions)

Proposed—Creates a select joint committee to study the Division of Highway Patrol of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles of the state of Florida and to report its findings and recommendations to the 1970 session of the legislature. SCR 212

Requests a study of present laws applying to juveniles and the state juvenile court system by the appropriate committees of the senate and house. SCR 334

Provides for appointment of members by the speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the senate to advise the legislature on social and scientific developments and problems, and authorizes the acceptance of federal and other grants for research. SB 353

Provides for the creation of a joint committee to study the grand jury system; requiring said committee to report to the next session of the legislature. SCR 531

Creates a select joint committee to study the problem of state aid to nonpublic schools and to report its findings and recommendations to the 1971 session of the legislature. SCR 604

Creates the Florida legislative commission on migrant labor and an advisory committee thereto; authorizes participation by Florida in the interstate migrant labor compact. SB 696

Creates the Florida study commission on a unicameral legislature; provides the membership, duties, powers, and functions of the commission; provides for a commission report and appropriation. SB 741

Provides for the appointment of a Committee of distinguished Floridians to serve as an advisory committee to the legislature to make recommendations of needed revisions of Florida's criminal justice system. SCR 790

Creates a select joint committee to conduct a study of mobile, modular, and pre-fabricated housing and to report its findings and recommendations to the 1971 session of the legislature. SCR 936

Authorizes the Department of Air and Water Pollution Control to conduct a comprehensive survey to determine the extent and nature of the litter problem in Florida; provides that a report be made to the speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the senate of the state of Florida at least forty-five days prior to the 1971 regular session of the legislature. SB 1098 ..

Provides for the appointment of an interim joint legislative committee to make a comprehensive study of all aspects of the role and status of the black citizen in the state of Florida; requires the making of a report to the legislature prior to March 1, 1971. SCR 1404

Creates the Florida legislative commission on the sale and ownership of condominium property and an advisory committee thereto, and provides for its composition, duties, and authority. SB 1418

Directs the secretary of the Department of Health and Rehabilitative services to conduct a comprehensive study into all aspects of safeguarding the health of elderly persons in boarding and retirement homes; requires the department to submit its findings prior to the beginning of the next legislative session. SB 1420

Provides for the creation of a joint committee to study the operation of the Florida Public Service Commission, to consider possible changes relative to the regulation of public utilities; requires said committee to report to the next session of the legislature. SCR 1427

Requests the president of the senate to direct the senate transportation committee to conduct an interim study into all aspects of the operation of the Florida Turnpike including, but not limited to, the operation of over-dimensional vehicles thereon, and into all aspects of the operation of overdimensional vehicles on all roads and highways and directing that the senate transportation committee report its findings to the senate in advance of the 1971 regular session of the legislature. Prefiled SR 8

Requests the president of the senate to direct the committee on commerce and licensed businesses to conduct an interim study into all aspects of the sale and ownership of condominium property and to report its findings to the senate prior to the 1971 regular session of the Florida legislature. Prefiled SR 9

Requests the president of the senate to appoint a select senate committee to make a study of the causes of racial tension in Florida and to report its findings and recommendations to the president in advance of the 1971 session of the legislature or, alternatively, to direct one of the standing senate committees to conduct such study and to report its findings and recommendations to the president in advance of the 1971 session of the legislature.
