

JOURNAL OF THE FLORIDA SENATE

Monday, February 7, 1972

The Senate was called to order by the President at 8:30 a.m. for the purpose of conducting the order of business of introduction and reference of resolutions, memorials, bills and joint resolutions pursuant to Rule 4.3.

INTRODUCTION

By Senator Boyd—

SB 548—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the division of universities of the department of education; authorizing the University of South Florida to establish an extension program in business and elementary and secondary education at Manatee Junior College; providing an appropriation.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Universities and Community Colleges and Ways and Means.

By Senator Hollahan—

SB 549—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Florida retirement system; amending section 121.081(1), Florida Statutes, by adding paragraph (c) to provide for retirement credit for employees in the Cuban Refugee Assistance Program for service prior to January 1, 1968; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Personnel, Retirement and Claims and Ways and Means.

By Senator Fincher—

SB 550—A bill to be entitled An Act relating to governmental reorganization; transferring from the board of trustees of the internal improvement trust fund to the division of archives, history and records management of the department of state all powers, duties and functions relating to patents, trademarks or copyrights under sections 286.021 and 286.031, Florida Statutes; adding subsection (12) to section 20.10, Florida Statutes, and amending sections 20.27, 286.021 and 286.031, Florida Statutes, 1970 Supplement, to effect such transfer; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Governmental Efficiency.

By Senators Graham and Haverfield—

SB 551—A bill to be entitled An Act implementing the provisions of Article VII, Section 15, of the Florida constitution upon ratification thereof by the electors; creating a student loan trust fund; authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to finance the establishment of the fund subject to the provisions of Article VII, Section 15, and the state bond act; providing that the department of general services, division of bond finance, shall determine the amount of such revenue bonds to be issued, not to exceed \$40,000,000; providing for fees in the student financial aid trust fund to be pledged as security for such bonds; revising section 8 of chapter 71-372, laws of Florida, acts of 1971; authorizing loans from the fund to students admitted to attend private or public institutions of higher learning, junior colleges, professional nursing diploma schools, or public vocational training centers; providing that the loans to be made with the proceeds of the fund shall be determined and approved by the department of education; providing for the administration and operation of the student loan trust fund; authorizing the execution of loan agreements; providing for the term of loans from the fund and for interest and other charges thereon; providing for the department of education to contract with insurance companies for insurance as security in the event of death or disability of the student borrower; providing for participation in the federally insured student loan program; providing that the provisions of this act shall be in addition to the other provisions of chapter 239, Florida Statutes; providing that the provisions hereof shall be separable; providing an effective date; providing that this act shall be null and void if said section 15 is rejected by the electors.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Universities and Community Colleges and Ways and Means.

By Senators Arnold, Brantley and Beaufort—

SB 552—A bill to be entitled An act relating to municipalities; providing authority to enact ordinances for the elimination of unsafe, unfit dwellings; providing compensation to the owner for the value of buildings and structures; providing notice to owner, mortgagees and lienholders of record; providing procedures for appeal and judicial review; providing for reasonable attorneys' fees; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Governmental Efficiency.

By Senator Hollahan—

SB 553—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the killing of a law enforcement officer, peace officer, prison guard, fireman, justice or judge; providing for the death penalty in convictions of first degree murder; and the jury recommendation; prohibits the granting of parole or probation for convictions where the death penalty is not imposed; prohibits the granting of parole or probation for those convicted of lesser degrees of murder; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary—Criminal.

By Senator Saunders—

SB 554—A bill to be entitled An act relating to extension service; providing for extension work between the cooperative extension service of the university of Florida's institute of food and agricultural sciences and boards of county commissioners and/or other legally constituted local governing bodies; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Universities and Community Colleges.

By Senator Saunders—

SB 555—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the department of education, division of universities; amending sections 245.07, 245.09, 245.14 and 245.16, Florida Statutes, relating to the disposition of dead bodies; providing a penalty; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Health, Welfare and Institutions.

By the Committee on Personnel, Retirement and Claims—

SB 556—A bill to be entitled An act relating to retirement; amending §§122.02(2), 122.08(4), 121.051(2)(a), Florida Statutes; creating §§122.021, 122.281, 122.052 and 121.082, Florida Statutes; amending the definition of "average final compensation"; providing for nonimpairment of certain retirement rights; expanding the classifications of contingent beneficiaries; providing for computation of benefits; providing that certain authorized leaves of absence count as creditable service; providing an open ended election option; providing that legislative attache service shall count as creditable service; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Personnel, Retirement and Claims and Ways and Means.

By Senator Lane—

SB 557—A bill to be entitled An act relating to maximum vehicle weights; amending Section 317.801, Florida Statutes, by renumbering and amending subsection (7), to provide review of penalties by the circuit court; repealing subsection (6); providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary—Civil A.

By Senator Brantley—

SB 558—A bill to be entitled An act relating to rate of wages for laborers, mechanics, and apprentices employed on public works; amending section 215.19(1), Florida Statutes, by adding paragraph (e); providing for inclusion of fringe benefits in prevailing wage rates; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary—Civil B.

By Senator Deeb—

SB 559—A bill to be entitled An act relating to county public health units; amending section 154.04, Florida Statutes, by providing that the directors thereof shall be doctors of medicine or doctors of osteopathy; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Health, Welfare and Institutions.

By Senator Lane—

SB 560—A bill to be entitled An Act relating to Broward County, Florida; amending section 9(a) of chapter 71-575, Laws of Florida; relating to the South Florida building code as applicable to Broward County; providing for the membership of the board of rules and appeals by adding two (2) firemen to said board; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 560.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Commerce and Rules, Calendar, Privileged Business and Ethics.

By Senator Bishop—

SB 561—A bill to be entitled An act relating to flue-cured tobacco; amending sections 574.03, 574.06, 574.07, 574.08, 574.09, 574.10, Florida Statutes, and creating section 574.14 of chapter 574, Florida Statutes; providing license and insurance for tobacco warehousemen and revocation of license; providing for reports and records of sales; requiring identification of tobacco by type and state of origin; authorizing rules; providing penalties, providing effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Agriculture and Ways and Means.

By Senator Boyd—

SB 562—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the division of marine resources of the department of natural resources;

providing an appropriation for a pilot research project and study of beach erosion in the state; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committees on Natural Resources and Conservation and Ways and Means.

By the Committee on Ways and Means—

SB 563—A bill to be entitled An Act relating to the income tax on corporations and other artificial entities; amending section 220.02, Florida Statutes, to express further legislative intent; amending paragraph 220.03(2)(c), Florida Statutes, to adopt by reference the federal Internal Revenue Code as in effect on January 1, 1972; amending paragraphs 220.13(1)(a) and (b), Florida Statutes, to remove the income tax exemption for United States securities and for obligations of the State of Florida and its political subdivisions; amending subsection 220.13(2), Florida Statutes, to clarify the limitation on life insurance company taxable income and to redefine the taxable income of banks, savings and loan associations and certain other financial institutions; amending subsection 220.15(3), Florida Statutes, to clarify the definition of "everywhere" in apportionment factor denominators; amending subsection 220.222(1), Florida Statutes, to provide a date for filing tax returns of Domestic International Sales Corporations and Florida partnerships; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By Senator Boyd—

SR 564—A resolution proposing a select committee of the Senate be appointed to study flood insurance; requiring a report of its findings and recommendations to the legislature.

—was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

By Senators McClain, Lane and Barrow—

SB 565—A bill to be entitled An act relating to health review committees and their staffs; providing that the proceedings of said committees shall not be subject to discovery except under certain conditions; providing an effective date.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary—Civil B.
