

# JOURNAL OF THE FLORIDA SENATE

Friday, April 27, 1973

The Senate was called to order by the President Pro Tempore for the purpose of conducting the order of business of introduction and reference of resolutions, memorials, bills and joint resolutions pursuant to Rule 4.3.

## INTRODUCTION

By Senator Poston—

SB 1326—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Monroe County; authorizing the District School Board of said county to erect, construct, repair, alter and improve any school building in Monroe County on a day labor basis, and to pay for the same with any funds from authorized sources when such erection, construction, repair, alteration or improvement costs do not exceed Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) for any one (1) such project, after plans for such work have been

approved by the Department of Education and have been advertised according to law and no responsive bid is submitted or the resulting lowest bid is ten per cent (10%), or more, in excess of the architect's estimate and requiring approval of State Department of Education before proceeding in accordance with the provisions of this Act; amending all laws or parts of laws, whether general or special, particularly Section 235.31, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 70-812, Acts of 1970, in conflict with this act, to the extent of such conflict; providing an effective date, and an expiration date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 1326.

—was read the first time by title and referred to the Committee on Rules and Calendar.
