Monday, April 29, 1974

## INTRODUCTION

The following measures were read the first time by title and referred to the committee(s) as indicated:

By Senator Deeb—

**SB 1081**—A bill to be entitled An act relating to Pinellas County; amending chapter 73-593, Laws of Florida, relating to the method of fixing millage; providing a method of fixing millage; providing that the county, school board, municipalities, and taxing districts shall decrease the millage required of said county, school board, municipalities, or taxing districts in proportion to the increase of the general level of assessed valuation of property; authorizing a ten percent increase in millage; providing for further millage increases in emergencies subject to limitations and review by the county budget commission; providing for verification of budgets and millage increases; specifying millages to be excluded from the reductions required by this act; requiring local taxing authorities to maintain millage necessary to participate in state funding programs;

providing that the millage to be levied by the school board in 1974 not exceed the maximum millage the board could levy in 1974 had the board been required to comply with certain sections of said chapter in the previous year; providing an effective date.

Evidence of notice and publication was established by the Senate as to SB 1081.
