FIRST READING

By the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Beard—

CS for SB 22-D—A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund; amending s. 945.215, F.S.; specifying an additional purpose for which moneys in the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund may be used; providing for proceeds of contraband possessed by inmates to be deposited in the Crimes Compensation Trust Fund in lieu of the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund; prescribing duties of the Treasurer and the Secretary of Corrections with respect to investment of moneys in the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund; providing an effective date.

By the Committee on Appropriations and Senators Silver, Dantzler and Grogan—

CS for SB 26-D—A bill to be entitled An act relating to correctional facilities construction and operation; authorizing the Governor to transfer certain funds to provide for the operation of correctional facilities currently under construction that may be completed ahead of schedule; authorizing the Department of Corrections to expend certain funds to replace certain bed capacity; authorizing the Department of Corrections to expend certain funds to renovate the Cape Orlando Community Correctional Center for a specified use; providing an effective date.
