

### **THREE-FOURTHS**

- (M) To enact bill for special election on constitutional amendment (Article XI, § 5(a))

### **THREE-FIFTHS**

- (P) To extend session (Article III, § 3(d))
- (M) To prohibit special law pertaining to specified subject (Article III, § 11(a)(21))
- (M) To create a trust fund (Article III, § 19(f)(1))
- (M) To exceed limit on corporate income tax (Article VII, § 5(b))
- (M) To propose constitutional amendment (Joint Resolution) (Article XI, § 1)

Note: (M)—membership      (P)—present and voting

### **CONSTITUTIONAL PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD**

General appropriation bills—72 hour public review period required before final passage (Article III, § 19(d))

Bills increasing state revenues—72 hour period after third reading before final passage (Article VII, § 1(e))

### **CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES**

Majority of members voting required for ratification of proposed amendment.
