

To exceed limitation on appropriations made for recurring purposes from nonrecurring general revenue funds [Art. III, s. 19(a)(2)]

To prohibit special law pertaining to specified subject [Art. III, s. 11(a)(21)]

To propose constitutional amendment (Joint Resolution) [Art. XI, s. 1]

Show of Hands:

Five (5) Senators may immediately question a vote declared by the President, requiring an electronic roll call [Art. III, s. 4(c)]

Two (2) committee members may question a vote declared by the chair, requiring a roll call vote [Art. III, s. 4(c)]

Two (2) committee members may request a roll call vote on any matter properly before the committee [Art. III, s. 4(c)]

CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

Financial Impact Statement Required:

A statement regarding the probable financial impact of any amendment proposed by initiative must be given to the public prior to the holding of an election [Art. XI, s. 5(b)]

Public Review Period:

Bills Increasing State Revenues

Seventy-two (72) hour period after third (3rd) reading before final passage [Art. VII, s. 1(e)]

General Appropriations Bills

Seventy-two (72) hour public review period required before final passage [Art. III, s. 19(d)]
