HEAD START

- 300 additional slots

WEATHERIZATION

- 400 homes per year through 2011
– 10 times as many as 2008
- Can receive \$3,000 to \$9,500
- Insulation, replacing doors and windows, improving A/C
- Low-income households, especially with senior or children

“SELF HELP”

- More than \$3 million , double last year's total funding
- Job-skill programs for low-income workers

JOB TRAINING

- Nearly \$22 million
- Programs target recently laid-off workers, youth and others

For Public Safety

POLICE

- Hiring 30 to 50 new officers
- Funding for Gun Bounty and Street Terror Offender programs
- Improved tracking of probation and parole
- Staff and software to combat mortgage fraud

SEAPORT

- Up to \$8 million for security upgrades and command center

VICTIM SERVICES

- \$500,000 for temporary housing to victims made homeless by domestic violence, stalking and sexual assault.

FIRE RESCUE

- Generators for fire engines and ambulances

PUBLIC HOUSING

- \$19 million for repairs and environmental upgrades
- Elevators, roofs, windows are likely top priorities

HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION

- \$7.4 million
- Rental assistance, security deposits, case management
