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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the State Personnel System Trust Fund without modification. The State Personnel System Trust Fund is administered by Department of Management Services.

II. SUBSTANTIVE RESEARCHS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 110.125, F.S. Creates the trust fund, provides revenues and statutory purpose

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the State Personnel System Trust Fund would provide funds for the administration of selected professional services, the training of new personnel, and for the development of a personnel database.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the State Personnel System Trust Fund is a \$59 per employee assessment fee charged to agencies.

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B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL RESEARCH & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
