**I. SUMMARY:**

This legislation re-creates the Florida School District Review Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Florida School District Review Trust Fund, FLAIR #11-2-560, is administered by the Legislative Branch, Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA). This fund was created effective July 1, 1998, by Chapter 98-225, Laws of Florida.

**II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:**

**A. PRESENT SITUATION:**

**1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:**

Section 230.23026, F.S., creates the trust fund and defines the uses of the fund. Section 230.23025, F.S., provides a revenue source for the fund.

**2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:**

The fund is used to pay costs of conducting best financial management practices reviews or reviews of components of the best practices in school districts.

**3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:**

The major source of revenue for the fund is a portion of the school district review costs received from OPPAGA. According the Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$252,973.16.

**B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:**

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
