**CS/HB 77** by Local Government & Veterans Affairs (SGC) and Sorensen (Similar S 0946)

**State Lottery Commission;** repeals certain provisions re said commission; abolishes said commission; deletes references to commission, to conform. Repeals 24.103(3),.106; amends 24.105,.108,.123. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.
