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## 12. Bills and Joint Resolutions on Third Reading

**HB 25** by Crow, Fiorentino, Weissman, Cantens, Lynn, Greenstein, Kravitz, Heyman, Spratt, Allen, Slosberg, Littlefield and Sobel (Compare H 1485, CS/S 0444, S 2038)

**Offenses Against Children**; revises provisions to prohibit certain previously convicted offenders from intentionally luring or enticing, or attempting to lure or entice, child under age 15 into structure, dwelling, or conveyance without consent of parent or legal guardian, or from intentionally luring or enticing, or attempting to lure or entice child away from child's parent or legal guardian, etc. Amends 787.025, 800.04, 947.1405; creates 794.07,.0701. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 73** by Council for Smarter Government, Wallace, Cantens, Byrd, Dockery and Murman (Identical CS/CS/S 0710)

**Fla. Customer Service Standards Act**; creates said act; provides definitions; specifies measures that state departments are directed to implement re interaction with their customers; provides requirements re operating hours; provides that failure to comply with act does not constitute cause of action; provides exceptions. Effective Date: 10/01/2001.

Read second time April 27

**CS/HB 83** by Council for Competitive Commerce and Russell (Similar CS/CS/S 0158, CS/CS/S 0668, Compare H 0145, H 0205, S 0818, CS/S 1216, S 1522)

**Enterprise Zone Designations**; removes 12/31/1999, deadline for creation of satellite enterprise zones by certain municipalities; authorizes Tourism, Trade, & Economic Development Office to designate enterprise zones in Sarasota Co. or Sarasota Co. & City of Sarasota jointly & Hernando Co. or Hernando Co. & City of Brooksville jointly; authorizes said office to designate enterprise zones in Holmes Co., Calhoun Co., & Okaloosa Co., etc. Amends Ch. 290. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 25

**CS/HB 93** by Transportation (RIC), Harrington, Henriquez, Bean and Wiles (Compare S 0712)

**Road & Bridge Designations**; redesignates old Nassau Sound Bridge in Nassau & Duval Counties as "George Crady Bridge"; designates portion of U.S. Highway 17 as "Doyle Parker Memorial Highway"; designates portion of State Road 77 as "Lynn Haven Parkway"; designates portion of Highway 41 in White Springs as "Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway"; designates portion of Semoran Boulevard in City of Orlando, Orange Co., as "Toni Jennings Boulevard", etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 26

**HB 159** by Rubio, Benson, Negron, Harrell, Barreiro, Prieguez, Waters, Diaz-Balart, Cusack, Lerner, Diaz de la Portilla and Slosberg (Similar CS/S 1568)

**HMO/Physicians/Adverse Determination**; provides licensure requirement for physician who renders adverse determination re services provided by another state-licensed physician; eliminates authority of certain out-of-state physicians to render such determinations. Amends 641.51. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 161** by Natural Resources & Environmental Protection (RIC) , Argenziano, Russell and Gibson (Similar S 1408)

**Citrus/Hernando Waterways Council**; creates Citrus/Hernando Waterways Restoration Council; provides for membership, powers, & duties; provides for separate county task forces; provides for advisory group to council; provides for report to Legislature; requires SWFWMD to provide staff for council; provides for Citrus/Hernando Waterways restoration program; provides program tasks; provides for award of contracts subject to appropriation of funds, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

Read second time and amended April 27

**HB 163 by Prieguez** (Similar S 0184)

**Tax/Collegiate Facility Renovation;** provides that publicly owned facilities within certain municipalities at which collegiate football team is based may use proceeds of sales taxes generated by facility for purpose of renovating facility; provides for reporting & remitting of such taxes. Amends 212.08. Effective Date: 01/01/2002.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 175 by Crime Prevention, Corrections & Safety (HCC), Machek, Slosberg, Andrews, Kendrick and Spratt** (Compare S 1088)

**Aggressive Careless Driving;** defines term “aggressive careless driving”; requires that HSMV revises uniform traffic citation upon future printings, to include special check-off box for law enforcement officers to use to indicate aggressive careless driving; requires department to make report to Legislature on number of aggressive careless driving incidents. Amends 316.650; creates 316.1923. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 26

**CS/CS/HB 179 by Information Technology (RIC), Child & Family Security (HCC), Lynn, Rich and Bucher**

**Child Care Facilities;** requires validation of information provided by applicant for child care facility license; requires CFS Dept. to establish database of information re violations, citations, & penalties imposed against child care facilities regulated by state; provides duties of State Technology Office; specifies which membership organizations are not considered child care facilities, etc. Amends 402.3055, .301, 409.146; creates 402.3105. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 26

**CS/HB 199 by Judicial Oversight (SGC), Trovillion and Crow** (Similar CS/CS/S 1814, Compare CS/H 1131, CS/CS/S 0912)

**Substance Abuse Treatment Programs;** provides goals for treatment-based drug courts; requires judicial circuits to establish model of said courts for certain purposes; provides certain principles for operating drug courts; provides for transferring persons eligible for participation in court treatment programs to other jurisdictions under certain circumstances; provides contracting requirements for entities providing such program, etc. Amends 910.035, 948.08; creates 948.16. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 203 by Information Technology (RIC), Ryan, Hogan, Paul, Melvin, Stansel, Kendrick, Spratt, Brutus, Henriquez, Smith, Justice, Fiorentino, Gelber, Mahon and Rich** (Similar H 0219, Compare H 0065, CS/CS/S 0144, S 0356)

**Child Pornography;** revises “Computer Pornography & Child Exploitation Act of 1986” to clarify certain penalties; prohibits transmissions of child pornography & any image, information, or data harmful to minors; requires public libraries to install & maintain computer software or equivalent technology that prohibits access to obscene materials by minors, etc. Amends 827.071, 847.001, .0135, 905.34; creates 847.0137, .0138, .0139. Effective Date: 07/01/2001 except as otherwise provided.

Read second time and amended April 26

**HB 251 by Kilmer, Atwater, Hogan, Haridopolos and Mack** (Similar S 0156)

**Sales Tax Exemption/Clothing;** specifies period during which sale of clothing & certain other items shall be exempt from such tax; defines “clothing”; provides exceptions; provides for rules. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time April 27

**CS/CS/HB 267 by Council for Lifelong Learning, Juvenile Justice (SGC), Kravitz, Barreiro, Davis, Wiles, Baxley, Needelman, Bean, Hogan, Negron, Kottkamp, Detert, Richardson, Gannon, Pickens, Fields, Byrd, Alexander, Berfield, Attkisson, Bendross-Mindingall, Prieguez, Betancourt, Melvin, Fiorentino, Farkas, Harrington, Wilson and Andrews** (Similar CS/S 0974)

**School Attendance/Violent Offenders;** requires schools to adopt policy of zero tolerance for victimization of students; requires each school district to enter into agreement with Juvenile Justice Dept. for purpose of protecting victims; requires principals to take certain actions when student has been victim of violent crime perpetrated by another student; prohibits certain persons from attending certain schools or riding on certain school buses under certain circumstances, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 281 by Colleges & Universities (LLC), Alexander and Lynn** (Similar CS/S 0302)

**Higher Educational Facilities;** creates “Higher Educational Facilities Financing Act”; creates Higher Educational Facilities Financing Authority; provides criteria for & covenants re authorization of issuance of notes & revenue bonds not obligating full faith & credit of authority, any municipality, state, or any political subdivision thereof; provides for loans from revenue bonds to participating institutions; provides for tax exemption, etc. Amends 196.012. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 293 by Information Technology (RIC), Crow and Mack** (Similar CS/S 1130)

**Certified Capital Company Act;** revises definitions; defines terms “Program One” & “Program Two”; revises procedures & dates for certification & decertification under Program One & Program Two; revises process for earning premium tax credits; provides limitation on tax credits under Program Two; authorizes Banking & Finance Dept. to levy fine; provides for distributions under both programs. Amends 288.99. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 337 by Tourism (CCC), Garcia, Arza, Diaz de la Portilla, Alexander and Lynn** (Identical CS/S 1010)

**Public Libraries;** extends repeal date of provision authorizing operating grants; requires Division of Library & Information Services to facilitate extension of free library services through interlocal agreement; requires reports. Amends 257.17. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 345 by Local Government & Veterans Affairs (SGC), Johnson, Trovillion and Henriquez** (Identical CS/S 0864)

**Sports Industry Economic Development;** provides for Revenue Dept. to distribute sales tax reimbursements to certified sports industry economic development projects under certain circumstances; creates tax reimbursement program for certified sports industry economic development projects; provides eligibility criteria for amateur sports businesses; provides for creation of new jobs in this state, etc. Amends 212.20, 213.053, 288.1229; creates 288.113. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 365 by State Administration (SGC), Hogan and Justice** (Similar CS/S 0840)

**Public Records/Health/Financial Info;** provides exemption from public records requirements for identifying information & specified financial information in records re individual's health or eligibility for health-related services made or received by Health Dept. or its service providers; specifies conditions under which such information may be released; provides for

future review & repeal; provides finding of public necessity. Amends 119.07. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time April 26

**CS/CS/HB 411** by Council for Smarter Government, Judicial Oversight (SGC), Kyle, Murman, Paul, Detert, Baxley, Hart, Byrd, Littlefield, Machek, Alexander, Spratt, Fiorentino, Mayfield, Farkas, Green, Bilirakis, Waters, Brummer, Crow, Kallinger, Kottkamp, Flanagan, Clarke, Bennett, Ross, Bowen, Russell, Harrington, Gannon, Dockery, Mealor, Cusack, Romeo, Johnson, Kosmas, Gibson, Negron, Allen, Lynn, Justice, Wiles and Haridopolos (Linked H 1265, CS/H 1397, Similar CS/CS/S 0442, Compare CS/S 1920)

**Florida Mobile Home Act**; defines term “proportionate share”; requires Fla. Land Sales, Condominiums, & Mobile Homes to maintain specified records; requires that copies be provided within specified time after written request; revises provisions re statements in prospectus; revises timeframes for giving notice of changes in lot rental amounts & use of mobile home parks; creates Fla. Mobile Home Relocation Corporation; provides penalty, etc. Amends Ch. 723. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/CS/HB 453** by Council for Ready Infrastructure, Utilities & Telecommunications (RIC), Prieguez, Diaz de la Portilla, Paul, Littlefield, Ryan, Attkisson, Ritter, Hogan, Barreiro, Siplin, Dockery, Murman and Haridopolos (Similar CS/S 1012)

**Energy Performance Savings**; changes provisions re energy efficiency contracting to provisions re guaranteed energy performance savings contracting; provides short title & legislative intent; revises definitions, procedures, & contract provisions; provides criteria, requirements, procedures, & limitations for energy performance contracts; provides for program administration & contract review by DMS & Office of Comptroller. Amends 489.145. Effective Date: 10/01/2001.

Read second time April 27

**CS/HB 455** by Banking (CCC) and Detert (Similar CS/S 1896)

**Mortgage Brokers & Lenders**; defines term “principal representative”; provides license renewal educational requirements for licensees & principal representatives; expands scope of mortgage business schools to include training for other persons; requires brokerage experience requirements for principal brokers; requires licensees to submit certification of completion of certain educational requirements by certain persons, etc. Amends Ch. 494. Effective Date: 10/01/2001 except as otherwise provided.

Read second time and amended April 27

**HB 457** by Lee, Waters, Holloway, Jennings, Bullard, Sobel, Brutus, Richardson, Greenstein, Frankel, Smith, Wilson, Peterman, Harper, Betancourt, Meadows, Prieguez, Atwater and Benson (Similar S 1220, Compare CS/S 0182)

**Property & Casualty Insurers**; increases period of exemption from certain taxes & assessments for certain minority businesses; extends future repeal. Amends 624.4072. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 463** by Colleges & Universities (LLC), Baxley, Heyman, Alexander, Melvin, McGriff and Detert (Similar S 1162, Compare CS/CS/H 1509)

**Florida Prepaid College Program**; revises accreditation requirements for independent college or university eligibility purposes; clarifies that amount of benefits transferred to eligible independent college or univ., eligible out-of-state college or univ., applied technology diploma program or vocational certificate program or refunded to purchaser shall not exceed

redemption value of advance payment contract at state postsecondary institution. Amends 240.551. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 26

**HB 465** by Baker, Clarke, Heyman, Betancourt, Bean, Berfield, Arza, Mealor, Jordan, Baxley, Kallinger, Trovillion, Alexander, Needelman, Attkisson, Stansel, Kendrick, Melvin, Pickens, McGriff, Mayfield and Wiles (Similar S 0940)

**Tuition/Residency/National Guard**; revises provisions re determinations of residency for tuition purposes to classify members of active Florida National Guard as residents for tuition purposes. Amends 240.1201. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 475** by Council for Healthy Communities, Hogan and Alexander (Linked H 0477, Similar CS/CS/S 1312, Compare H 1075, H 1471, CS/ H 1879, CS/H 1895, S 0362, CS/S 0688, S 0702, S 1314, CS/S 1902, CS/S 2158)

**Public Health**; expands type of personnel & facilities that may accept abandoned newborns; amends provision re Florida Patient's Bill of Rights & Responsibilities to replace references to term “physical handicap” with term “handicap”; requires postnatal tests & screenings for infant metabolic disorders to be performed by State Public Health Laboratory; revises provisions re food service employee training programs, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2001 except as otherwise provided.

Read second time April 26

**HB 477** by Hogan and Alexander (Linked CS/H 0475, Similar S 1314, Compare CS/H 0141, CS/H 0415, CS/ CS/S 0138, CS/CS/S 1312)

**Public Records/Parents ID/Newborns**; provides exemption from public records requirements for information that identifies parents who leave newborn infants at emergency medical services stations; provides exception; provides exemption from public records requirements for information contained in Paternity Registry; provides for future legislative review & repeal; provides findings of public necessity. Amends 383.51. Effective Date: Contingent.

Read second time and amended April 26

**HB 509** by Attkisson and Murman (Compare S 0078)

**Relief/Hopkins & Bowman**; provides for relief of Towanna Denise Hopkins, incompetent, by & through Willie Lee Hopkins, her father & legally appointed guardian, Robert Keith Bowman, Jr., son of Towanna Denise Hopkins, & Willie Lee Hopkins, individually; authorizes & directs Fla. Board of Regents, USF, & USF Health Sciences Center Insurance Co. to compensate them for injuries & damages sustained as result of negligence of agents, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time April 27

**HB 531** by Gardiner, Johnson, Lynn, Lerner, Heyman and Gelber (Similar CS/H 1231, CS/CS/S 1282, Compare H 1049, S 1536)

**Property Crimes**; provides second-degree felony penalties for theft of certain emergency medical equipment & theft of certain cargo; provides third-degree felony penalty for certain commission of retail theft; provides criminal penalties for dealing in stolen property by use of Internet; prohibits forging check or draft or possessing or passing forged check or draft, etc. Amends Chs. 812, 831, 832.05, 921.0022; creates 817.625. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 25

**HB 559** by Peterman, Fields, Bendross-Mindingall, Richardson, Henriquez, Wilson, Waters, Bilirakis, Crow, Carassas, Berfield, Farkas, Joyner, Justice and Wallace (Identical S 1270)

**Pinellas Co. School Board;** provides for seven-member district school board, with four members elected from single-member districts & three members elected from county at large, notwithstanding certain provisions; provides for implementation at specified elections; provides that school board members shall continue to be elected on nonpartisan basis & shall be elected in conjunction with first primary & general election; provides for referendum, etc. Effective Date: Contingent.

Read second time April 26

**HB 575** by Baker, Fiorentino, Detert, Kallinger, Clarke, Hart, Brown, Baxley, Trovillion, Bean, Green, Johnson, Alexander, Gottlieb, Brutus, Rich, Cantens, Romeo, Mack, Haridopolos, Carassas, Diaz de la Portilla and Atwater (Similar S 1620)

**Filing Fees/Corporate Fee;** authorizes Dept. of State to discount certain filing fees under certain circumstances; provides exception to imposition of late charge for supplemental corporate fee under certain circumstances. Amends 15.16, 607.193. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read second time and amended April 27

**HB 579** by Crow (Similar CS/S 0386)

**Uniform Commercial Code;** cites act as Uniform Commercial Code-Secured Transactions; provides for effectiveness & attachment of security agreements; provides for perfection & priority of security interests; prescribes rights of third parties; prescribes filing procedures for perfection of security interest; provides that, for goods bought for personal, family, or household purposes, buyer's right of replevin vests upon acquisition of special property, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time April 27

**CS/HB 605** by Elder & Long-Term Care (HCC), Gibson, Kravitz, Byrd, Mahon and Fiorentino (Compare H 1641, CS/CS/CS/S 1202, CS/CS/S 1456)

**Florida Alzheimer's Training Act;** creates said act; revises training standards for employees of assisted living facilities that provide care for residents with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders; prescribes training standards for employees of certain facilities that provide care for persons with said disease or said disorders; directs Elderly Affairs Dept. to convene working group to develop training guidelines, etc. Creates 400.1755,.4786,.55715,.626; amends 400.4178. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/CS/HB 617** by Council for Healthy Communities, Juvenile Justice (SGC), Harper, Gelber, Barreiro, Richardson, Peterman, Smith, Greenstein, Weissman, Slosberg, Bucher, Bullard, Fields, Heyman, Romeo, Gannon and McGriff (Similar CS/S 0322, Compare H 1423)

**Youthful Offenders;** requires that certain inmates who are less than specified age be placed in specific correctional facilities & housed in separate dormitories; requires that DOC report to Legislature on its compliance with requirements for housing youthful offenders; requires that certain inmates who are less than specified age & who have no prior juvenile adjudication be placed in facilities for youthful offenders, etc. Amends 944.1905, 921.0021. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Read second time and amended April 27

**CS/HB 623** by State Administration (SGC), Mack, Byrd, Dockery, Argenziano, McGriff and Haridopolos (Similar CS/S 0822, Compare H 1977, CS/S 1784)

**Government Accountability;** provides that property of state or monetary recovery made on behalf of state is not subject to lien; clarifies current requirement that contractor on certain state contracts must allow access to public records unless records are exempt; provides for injunctions without bond when sought by state or its agencies; authorizes Risk Management Division to enter into indemnification agreements for supersedeas bonds, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2001.

Effective Date: 07/01/2001.
