I. SUMMARY:

This legislation terminates the Retiree Health Insurance Subsidy Trust Fund, Flair #72-2-583, effective November 4, 2004 and re-creates the same, without modification on November 4, 2004. The Retiree Health Insurance Subsidy Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services. This fund was last reviewed by the legislature in Chapter 97-140, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The Retiree Health Insurance Subsidy Trust Fund provides funding for retiree health insurance subsidies to be administered within the Department of Management Services.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenues for the Retiree Health Insurance Subsidy Trust Fund are monthly transfers from each state and local agency participating in the Florida Retirement System and interest earnings.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill terminates and re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply terminates and re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
