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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Administrative Trust Fund, Flair #72-2-021, without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Administrative Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 97-137, Laws of Florida.
