I. Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 – 044365 (body and title)

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 allows a thoroughbred permitholder to conduct live racing and operate a cardroom at the same time. The amendment include the contents of the greyhound adoption bill (CS/SB 1692). It include the contents of CS/SB 104 relating to cardrooms.

The Charity Racing Days provision is amended to require all proceeds fund programs and operations in Florida only.

Provides for an appraisal of Hialeah Park directed by the DBPR to determine whether the state should purchase the facilities.

Appropriates \$50,000 from the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund, but has not been included in the appropriations bill. Effective July 1, 2001, unless otherwise provided.
