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Senator Mitchell moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 64, between lines 27 and 28,

insert:

Section 58. A contract for services, request for proposal, or invitation to bid between an agency of this state and a contract vendor succeeding to the operation of a program or function of an agency of this state may not be executed unless the vendor is a corporation that is domiciled in this state or that will maintain a significant business presence in this state for the duration of the contract. For the purposes of this section, the term "significant business presence" means a retention of substantially all of the filled positions previously assigned the state agency at substantially the same total cash equivalent of salaries and benefits.
