SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

HB 69-C by Representative Ball

Inmate Welfare Trust Fund; revises provisions establishing amount of weekly draw inmates are allowed to request from their individual accounts in trust fund. Amends 945.215. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

HB 25-C by Representative Fasano

Working Capital Fund/Transfers; reenacts specified provision to implement transfer of moneys to Working Capital Fund from certain trust funds. Reenacts 215.32(2)(b). Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

SB 80-C by Senator Pruitt

Intangible Property Tax; postpones increase in exemptions under tax on intangible property; authorizes DOR to adopt emergency rules. Amends 199.185. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Finance and Taxation

SB 64-C by Senator Silver and others

Local Government/Financial Emergency; ratifies actions taken by local governments pursuant to specified provision before its amendment by Senate Bill 54-B. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Finance and Taxation

CS/SB 66-C by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Latvala

LES Department; transfers & reassigns divisions, functions, & responsibilities of LES Dept.; provides for comparable pay grades for transferred positions; authorizes DOI to reorganize positions within dept. & establish regional offices; authorizes Banking & Finance Dept., in conjunction with Attorney General's Office, to use unexpended funds to settle certain claims; establishes Workers' Compensation Division within DOI, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 01/01/2002.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance

CS/SB 28-C by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Brown-Waite and others

Public Records/Inspection/Copying; authorizes delay in inspection or copying of public record under limited circumstances; establishes procedures & standards; limits applicability of provision; provides statement of public necessity. Amends 119.07. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice

CS/SB 36-C by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Clary

Expanded Homeownership Assistance; creates Expanded Homeownership Assistance Program within Florida Housing Finance Corporation; provides for loans to eligible borrowers for down payments or closing costs related to purchase of residences; provides for repayment of loans; authorizes fee; requires deposit & authorizes expenditure of certain revenues; requires adoption of rules; provides for future repeal. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations

SB 56-C by Senator Cowin and others

United States Flag; provides that it is unlawful to prohibit display of flag of United States; provides penalty. Creates 256.15. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably, with two amendments, by the Committee on Criminal Justice


