### **HB 361 by Diaz de la Portilla (Similar S 0062)**

**Relief/Millie Jackson/Miami-Dade Co.;** provides for relief of Millie Jackson & compensates her for injuries & damages sustained as result of negligent acts by employee of Miami-Dade County. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 363 by Fields (Similar S 0058)**

**Relief/Polices & Cora Donaldson;** provides for relief of Willie Police, III, Cora Donaldson, Willie Police, Sr., & Estate of Willie Police, Jr.; authorizes & directs City of Belle Glade to compensate them for injuries suffered as result of death of Willie Police, Jr., due to negligence of employees of city. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 365 by Paul (Identical S 0500)**

**Claims/Engineers/Architects/Mappers;** provides definitions; requires claimants to serve engineers, architects, & licensed professional surveyors & mappers with preliminary expert opinion when it is deemed that expert opinion testimony will be necessary to prove standard of care required of engineer, architect, or licensed professional surveyor & mapper in support of claim. Creates 45.08. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

### **HB 367 by Justice, Bucher, Gibson, Kravitz, Baker, Crow, Meadows, Jordan, Cusack and Seiler**

**Disabled Veterans/License Plate;** authorizes certain veterans to apply for license plate with wheelchair symbol; provides for annual use fee; provides for disposition of fee; provides for collection of other required fees. Amends 320.0842. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

### **HB 369 by Lee (Compare S 0018)**

**Relief/McCarty/Bailey/Decker;** provides for relief of Kathleen McCarty, individually & as personal representative of Estate of Laura Bailey, deceased, & George Decker & Joan Decker, individually & as co-personal representatives of Estate of Christina Decker; compensates them for losses sustained as result of actions of CFS Dept. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 371 by Meadows (Identical S 0048)**

**Relief/Nicholas Maracic/Broward Co.;** provides for relief of Nicholas Maracic; compensates him for injuries sustained as result of negligence of said county. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 373 by Kendrick (Identical S 0072)**

**Relief/Jacob P. Darna/Lee Co. School;** provides for relief of Jacob P. Darna, a minor, for injuries sustained as result of negligence of Lee County School Board. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 375 by Bullard (Identical S 0066)**

**Relief/Harley & Dent;** provides for relief of Mary Nell Dent Harley, as legal guardian of Ariel Alexis Dent, for injuries sustained by Ariel Alexis Dent as result of negligence on part of employee of Palm Beach County School Board. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

### **HB 377 by Clarke**

**Florida Arts Council/Dept. of State;** revises membership of & appoints authority for Florida Arts Council; provides for terms of members; provides limitation on consecutive terms of membership; provides qualifications for council appointees; revises duty of council; revises scope of challenge grant program authorized by Cultural Affairs Div. of Dept. of State; provides match ratio criteria for local, regional, & state or capital projects. Amends 265.285,.286. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

### **HB 379 by Brutus**

**Paternity/DNA Testing**; requires DNA testing at birth & maintenance of such records by Health Dept.; provides for analysis by court order; requires that determination of paternity proceedings be electronically recorded; authorizes new trial re determination of paternity under certain circumstances; provides conditions for granting of relief re motion for new trial; provides for genetic testing, payment of fees, & costs. Creates 382.0136, 742.125; amends 742.011. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 381 by Wallace**

**Small Business/Tax Credit Vouchers**; provides for issuing tax credit vouchers; requires DOR to develop forms & procedures; limits availability of credit vouchers. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 383 by Mahon**

**Local Option Ninth-cent Fuel Tax**; provides that certain counties levying said tax shall receive preference points to calculate eligibility for receipt of any transportation grant for which county applies. Amends 339.12. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 385 by Lee (Similar S 0320, Compare H 0109)**

**Property & Casualty Insurers**; increases period of exemption from certain taxes & assessments for certain minority businesses; extends future repeal. Amends 624.4072. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 387 by Lee**

**Property & Casualty Insurance Risk**; provides that nursing homes & assisted living facilities are immediately eligible for coverage in Fla. Property & Casualty Joint Underwriting Association; provides that rates used by association are subject to specified provision; eliminates provisions tying initial rates of association to rates contained in Insurance Services Office filing with DOI. Amends 627.351. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

**HB 389 by Lerner, Heyman, Needelman, McGriff, Jennings, Bennett, Trovillion, Russell, Kosmas, Justice, Stansel, Kendrick, Kravitz, Flanagan, Spratt, Alexander, Argenziano, Littlefield, Baxley, Prieguez, Peterman, Romeo, Bendross-Mindingall, Kallinger, Baker, Jordan, Meadows, Ball, Gannon, Gottlieb, Evers, Kilmer, Maygarden and Hogan (Identical S 0188)**

**Law Officer/Firefighter/Manslaughter**; provides that person who causes death of law enforcement officer or firefighter through culpable negligence commits offense of aggravated manslaughter; provides enhanced penalty. Amends 782.07. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 391 by Garcia**

**Mayra Capote Act**; creates said act; authorizes district school boards to prohibit high school students from leaving high school campus during lunch periods. Amends 230.23005. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 393 by Simmons**

**Motor Veh. Financial Responsibility**; revises definition of term "motor vehicle"; increases financial responsibility limits re bodily injury or death in single accident; requires proof of financial responsibility for bodily injury or death; increases limits for proof of financial responsibility for for-hire transportation vehicle certificates of self-insurance; increases amount required for surety bond or deposit for proof of financial responsibility, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 395 by Detert, Ausley and Gannon**

**Commodity Procurement/Definition**; revises definition of commodity to include certain accounting services. Amends 287.012. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 397 by Bennett**

**Manatee Co. Mosquito Control Dist.**; codifies, reenacts, amends, & repeals special acts re district; provides charter; provides for formation as independent special district; provides boundaries; provides for election of commissioners & operation of district in accordance with specified provision; provides for district powers,

functions, & duties; provides for construction & effect. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 399 by Bennett**

**Florida Mobile Home Act**; provides for meeting between park owner & committee of affected mobile home owners re certain lot rental amount increases; revises language re payments by mobile home park owner to Florida Mobile Home Relocation Trust Fund. Amends 723.037,.06116. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 401 by Argenziano**

**Community College Education/Civics**; requires community college general education requirements to include civics instruction which focuses on American national government. Amends 240.325. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 403 by Barreiro (Similar H 0129)**

**Motorsports Entertainment Complex**; provides for distribution of portion of revenues from tax on sales, use, & other transactions to motorsports entertainment complex; provides for certification of such facility by Office of Tourism, Trade, & Economic Development of Executive Office of Governor; provides requirements for certification; provides for use of funds distributed to motorsports entertainment complex, etc. Amends 212.20; creates 288.1170. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

#### **HB 405 by Rich**

**Prescription Plans**; requires certain employers to ensure that prescription plans include certain coverage, are comprehensive, & do not discriminate on basis of gender; provides for penalties. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HM 407 by Allen**

**Retired Pay Restoration Act of 2001**; urges Congress to pass "Retired Pay Restoration Act of 2001," which permits retired members of United States Armed Forces with service-connected disabilities to be paid both military retirement pay & veterans' disability compensation.

#### **HB 409 by Bilirakis (Similar S 0408)**

**DOC/Criminal Investigations**; provides for designation of certain persons as law enforcement officers & authorizes such persons to have certain powers & duties; revises provisions re use of force by department employees & responsibility & guidelines for investigations thereof. Amends 944.31,.35. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 411 by Farkas**

**Mental Illness Health Insurance**; extends applicability of provisions re mental illness health insurance coverage; requires Legislative Services Office to contract for completion of report on proposed health benefit coverage for serious mental illness; provides definition; specifies report review requirements. Amends 627.6685. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 413 by Farkas**

**Centralized Prescription Filling**; defines term "centralized prescription filling"; authorizes centralized prescription filling by one pharmacy for another pharmacy & provides requirements therefor; requires maintenance of policy & procedures manual, subject to inspection by Board of Pharmacy or its agent upon request, & provides requirements therefor; requires board to adopt rules to implement section. Amends 465.003; creates 465.0265. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 415 by Farkas**

**Prostitution/Substance Abuse**; requires certain offenders to be screened for substance abuse; requires offender who tests positive for substance abuse to attend treatment program under certain circumstances; provides requirements for sentencing defendant for failure to complete treatment program. Amends 796.07. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

#### **HB 417 by Prieguez**

**Alcoholic Bev./Students/Curriculum;** provides exemption for giving or serving to certain underage students alcoholic beverages that are delivered as part of required curriculum at accredited institution; provides exemption for possession of alcoholic beverages by underage students in specified circumstances. Amends 562.11,.111. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 419 by Brown** (Similar S 0014)

**Relief/McIntires/DOT;** compensates Billie Jo McIntire, as surviving spouse & Personal Representative of Estate of Jeffrey Scott McIntire, deceased, & Sarah Ellen Megan McIntire & Christian Jeffrey Taylor McIntire, surviving minor children of Jeffrey Scott McIntire, deceased, for wrongful death of their husband & father, Jeffrey Scott McIntire, as result of negligence of Florida Transportation Department. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 421 by Weissman** (Compare S 0356)

**Funeral & Cemetery Services;** reduces minimum acreage requirements for cemeteries; revises requirements for purchase of burial rights & for deposit of payments from sales of burial rights into care & maintenance trust funds; revises amounts required to be placed in trust for services & merchandise under preneed contract; provides limit on interest that may be held in insurance company providing security on or acting as servicing agent for preneed contract, etc. Amends Ch. 497. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 423 by Kendrick**

**Tri-County Hospital Authority;** (Dixie, Gilchrist & Levy Counties) repeals chapter 84-423, Laws of Florida, re Tri-County Hospital Authority. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 425 by Prieguez** (Identical S 0030)

**Relief/Hilda De Paz/Miami-Dade Co.;** provides for relief of Hilda De Paz; authorizes & directs Miami-Dade Co. to compensate Hilda De Paz for personal injuries she suffered due to negligence of county employees. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 427 by Brown and Flanagan** (Identical S 0470 )

**Insurance Plans Participation;** prohibits requiring contractors or subcontractors under certain contracts to participate, or be penalized for nonparticipation, in certain insurance plans. Amends 255.05, 287.055,.057. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 429 by Gibson**

**Alcohol License/Retirement Community;** authorizes issuance of special alcoholic beverage license for certain entities operating within commercial district of retirement community within Town of Lady Lake & for certain entities operating within commercial district of retirement community within Sumter County; provides restrictions. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 431 by Sorensen**

**Public Records/Guardian Ad Litem;** provides exemption from public records requirements for specified identifying information re staff & certified volunteers of child guardian ad litem programs & their spouses & children; provides for future review & repeal; provides finding of public necessity. Amends 119.07. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 433 by Andrews**

**Pari-mutuel/Intertrack Wagering;** reduces rate of tax on handle for certain jai alai permitholders who conduct intertrack wagering; revises language re intertrack wagering; removes limitation on receiving broadcasts of certain races or games. Amends 550.09511,.615. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 435 by Kyle**

**Transportation/Public-Private;** provides for public-private transportation facilities; eliminates requirement that Legislature approve such facilities; provides requirements for use of funds from State Transportation Trust Fund; provides requirements re proposals; provides for specific project approval by Legislature for certain projects; authorizes DOT to create certain corporations to

shield state from possible financial risks for projects, etc. Amends 334.30. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 437 by Haridopolos**

**School Relocatables/District Admin.;** requires school district administrative personnel to move into relocatables & existing school district administrative facilities to be used for additional classroom space under certain circumstances. Amends 235.061. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 439 by Stansel, Mahon, Kravitz, Gibson, Attkisson, Melvin and Baxley** (Similar S 0496)

**Military/Dependent Education Benefit;** provides educational opportunity at state expense for dependent children of military personnel who died or suffered service-connected 100-percent total & permanent disability in Operation Enduring Freedom; specifies documentation which constitutes proof of eligibility for such benefits. Creates 295.0185. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 441 by Cantens**

**License Plate/Breast Cancer Research;** provides for Breast Cancer Research license plate; provides for use fee; directs HSMV to develop said license plate; provides for distribution & use of fees. Amends 320.08056,.08058. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 443 by Barreiro** (Identical S 0532)

**Firesafety Standards;** requires State Fire Marshal to adopt uniform standards as provided in specified provisions; prescribes conditions for conducting firesafety inspections; requires State Fire Marshal to adopt & administer rules prescribing specified standards for safety & health of occupants of educational & ancillary plants & educational & ancillary facilities as specified, etc. Amends 235.06, 633.01,.022. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

**HB 445 by Hogan** (Similar S 0378)

**Public Record/Utility/Customer Info.;** exempts from public records requirements certain customer personal information held by publicly owned utilities; provides for review & repeal; provides statement of public necessity. Amends 119.07. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

**HB 447 by Bennett**

**Manatee Co./North River Fire Dist.;** codifies district charter; provides boundaries; provides for Board of Fire Commissioners; provides for elections & for filling of vacancies; provides authority to levy special assessments; provides for liens; provides for public hearings; provides for deposit of funds & for use of funds; provides borrowing power of district; provides authority & power to acquire certain property; provides for impact fees, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 449 by Bennett**

**Parrish Fire Control District;** (Manatee Co.) increases rates for special assessments & increases impact fees re said district. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HB 451 by Atwater**

**Palm Beach Co./Palm Beach Shores;** authorizes Town of Palm Beach Shores to exercise its police powers & jurisdiction extending 1,200 feet into waters of Atlantic Ocean adjacent to its established corporate limits. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

**HJR 453 by Harrington**

**Hunting, Fishing, & Gaming Rights;** constitutional amendment to establish right of people of state to hunt, fish, & harvest game, subject to reasonable regulations & restrictions as prescribed by general law & State Constitution. Amends s. 26, Art. I.

**HB 455 by Kallinger**

**Investigative & Security Services;** revises requirements for initial application for licensure to perform private investigative, private

security, & repossession services; revises provisions re investigation of applicants by Dept. of State; provides that performance of certain services is not creditable toward experience requirements for specified classes of licensure to perform private investigative services; conforms terminology, etc. Amends Ch. 493; reenacts various FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 457 by Spratt**

**Bridge Designations;** designates new U.S. Highway 27 bridge in City of Moore Haven as "Mamie Langdale Memorial Bridge"; designates old Nassau Sound Bridge in Nassau & Duval Counties as "George Crady Bridge"; directs DOT to erect suitable markers. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 459 by Kilmer**

**Bright Futures Scholarship Program;** revises eligibility requirements; provides eligibility requirements for students who enter military service; provides for reinstatement of awards; provides for Florida Bright Futures Scholarship awards for students attending United States military service academies; provides for issuance of warrants; provides that receipt of awards shall be retroactive under certain conditions; provides for repeal. Amends 240.40201, .40202; creates 240.40215. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 461 by Ball**

**Enterprise Zone/Brevard County;** authorizes Office of Tourism, Trade, & Economic Development to designate enterprise zone in Brevard Co.; provides requirements with respect thereto. Creates 290.00686. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 463 by Garcia**

**Student Courses/Withdrawal/Military;** requires rules & policies by district school boards, community college district boards of trustees, & university boards of trustees re student withdrawal from courses due to military service; provides that student shall not suffer academic or financial penalties; authorizes refund of fees. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 465 by Baxley**

**Military Children/Residency/Tuition;** provides for classification as residents of dependent children of certain active duty members of Armed Services for tuition purposes. Amends 240.1201. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 467 by Garcia**

**Controlled Substance/Within 1000 Ft.;** prohibits sale, manufacture, or delivery of controlled substances, or possession of controlled substances with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, within 1,000 feet of any postsecondary educational institution, public park, or public housing facility; provides penalties; ranks such offenses on offense severity ranking chart of Criminal Punishment Code. Amends 893.13, 921.0022. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

#### **HB 469 by Bense (Similar S 0082)**

**Relief/Verela/Iglesias/Avendano/DOT;** provides for relief of Maria Verela, as personal representative of Estate of Veronica Barcos, deceased, & Carlos Barcos as guardian of Janessa Barcos & Natalee Barcos, minor children of Veronica Barcos, & for relief of Ligia Iglesias & Alba Luz Avendano, as co-personal representatives of Estate of Zuleima Torres, deceased, & as co-guardians of Ashley Barcos & Gianni Barcos, minor children of Zuleima Torres, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 471 by Sorensen**

**Monroe Co./Key Largo Wastewater;** creates Key Largo Wastewater Treatment District, independent special district; specifies

boundaries of district, consisting of certain land areas transferred from Fla. Keys Aqueduct Authority; provides powers & duties of district; provides for membership, qualifications, terms, powers, duties, & compensation of governing board; terminates jurisdiction of Fla. Keys Aqueduct Authority over all lands transferred to district, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 473 by Gardiner**

**Use of "Chamber of Commerce" Term;** prohibits certain business entities from using term "chamber of commerce" under certain circumstances; provides penalty; authorizes chambers of commerce to sue certain business entities to enjoin use of such term. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 475 by Seiler (Identical S 0208)**

**School Facilities;** provides example of school-within-a-school; modifies small-school student-population limits; provides for exceptions to small-schools requirements. Amends 230.23, 235.2157. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 477 by Baker**

**McTureous Memorial Highway/Lake Co.;** designates portion of State Road 19 in Lake Co. as "PFC Robert M. McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor Memorial Highway"; directs DOT to erect suitable markers. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 479 by Slosberg**

**Elderly/Disabled Adults/Exploitation;** specifies statute of limitations for exploitation of funds, assets, or property of elderly person or disabled adult; provides for tolling of certain statutes of limitations under certain circumstances. Amends 825.103. Effective Date: 10/01/2002.

#### **HB 481 by Argenziano (Identical S 0292)**

**HS Diploma/Korean War Veterans;** provides for award of standard high school diploma to certain Korean War Veterans. Amends 232.246. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 483 by Stansel**

**Inmate Welfare Trust Fund;** prohibits use of funds for certain purposes. Amends 945.215. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 485 by Romeo**

**Temple Terrace Parkway/State Rd. 580;** designates portion of State Road 580 in City of Temple Terrace as "Temple Terrace Parkway"; directs DOT to erect suitable markers. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

#### **HB 487 by Seiler (Identical S 0528)**

**Attorney's Fees;** provides for serving of motions seeking sanctions allowed for unsupported claims or defenses or delay of litigation. Amends 57.105. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 489 by Henriquez (Similar S 0526)**

**Land Surveying & Mapping;** exempts certain subordinate employees from provisions re regulation of land surveying & mapping; provides rulemaking authority to Board of Professional Surveyors & Mappers re use of professional titles by retirees; deletes obsolete prerequisite to take licensure examination to practice as surveyor & mapper; deletes rulemaking authority for review & approval of military schools & federal training & apprenticeship programs, etc. Amends Ch. 472. Effective Date: 07/01/2002.

#### **HB 491 by Goodlette (Identical S 0512)**

**Civil Legal Assistance Act;** creates Florida Access to Civil Legal Assistance Act; provides definitions; specifies powers of DCA for certain purposes; limits use of certain funds for certain purposes; requires DCA to contract for delivery of said assistance to certain persons through not-for-profit legal aid organizations; provides contract requirements; specifies application; requires DCA to ensure accountability; provides for eligibility for state support, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.


