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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Administration Trust Fund, FLAIR number 802021, without modification. The Administration Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

The trust fund is not in statute.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund supports administrative activities of the Department of Juvenile Justice.

For the 2001-2002 fiscal year, the Legislature appropriated \$1,332,134.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of revenue for the Administration Trust Fund is indirect earnings from Title IV-A and other federal programs and provider criminal history background check fees.

Total receipts for FY 2000-01 were \$3.1 million. Estimated receipts for both FY 2001-02 and FY 2002-03 are \$695,767.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
