**I. Summary:**

This legislation re-creates the Crew Chief Registration Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Crew Chief Registration Trust Fund, FLAIR #79-2-147, is administered by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. It was transferred from the Department of Labor and Employment Security, by Chapter 2002-194, Laws of Florida. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-67, Laws of Florida.

**II. Present Situation:**

The fund is used for administrating the Federal Migrant Seasonal Protection Act. The program registers farm labor contractors and contractor employees (crew chiefs). The purpose of the program is to protect migrant and seasonal farm workers from exploitation and harmful work situations. According to Comptroller date, receipts to the fund total \$313,815 in FY 2001-02.
