Appropriations; provides moneys for annual period beginning July 1, 2002, & ending June 30, 2003, to pay salaries, & other expenses, capital outlay – buildings, & other improvements, & for other specified purposes of various agencies of State government. Appropriation: \$50,408,981,797. Effective Date: 07/01/2002 except as otherwise provided.

**H 69-E GENERAL BILL/1ST ENG by Brummer; Johnson; (CO-SPONSORS) Lynn (Similar S 0070-E)**

Transportation; allows toll revenues of certain facilities to be used as security for bonds issued to finance transportation projects in county or counties in which revenue-producing facility is located; prohibits Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority from serving as community transportation coordinator; repeals s. 1, SB 100, 2002 Regular Session, re authority acting as community transportation coordinator, etc. Amends 338.165, 339.12, 343.64. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.
