Engineering; exempts certain persons in defense, space, & aerospace industries from licensure under Engineering law; defines terms “space or aerospace company” & “defense company”; clarifies that certain persons who are exempt from licensure may practice engineering; clarifies which professional titles such exempt persons may use. Amends 471.003, 005, 031. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Lottery/Unclaimed Prize Money; requires that specified unclaimed prize money be transferred to Educational Enhancement Trust Fund; provides appropriation from trust fund to community colleges as matching funds for certain private donations; provides appropriation from trust fund to state universities as matching funds for certain private donations; provides for allocation of such funds. Appropriation: \$30,147,947. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Governor/One-time Stay; authorizes Governor to issue one-time stay to prevent withholding of nutrition & hydration under certain circumstances; provides for expiration of stay; authorizes Governor to lift stay at any time; provides for revocation of stay; provides that person is not civilly liable & is not subject to regulatory or disciplinary sanctions for taking action in compliance with any such stay. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Workers' Compensation; (THIS BILL COMBINES S14-E, 16-E) provides that any licensee under Contracting law who forms corporation in order to become eligible for exemption from certain requirements for workers' compensation coverage is not required to obtain approval for change of status or for qualified business organization license under said law until July 1, 2004; redefines term “corporate officer” for purposes of Workers' Compensation law, etc. Amends 440.02. Effective Date: 11/12/2003.

Workers' Compensation; (THIS BILL COMBINED IN CS/S14-E & 16-E) changes from January 1, 2004, to July 1, 2004, effective date of amendments made by chapter 2003–412, Laws of Florida, to specified provisions which govern coverage requirements for workers' compensation, election of exemption from coverage requirements, & effect of such election. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Phosphate Mining; amends tax on phosphate rock & provides for distribution of tax proceeds; directs DEP to amend master reclamation plan; creates not-for-profit partnership to assist in phosphate reclamation; provides authority for variance for certain reclamation activities; allows variances for water supply development; provides for declaration of imminent hazard if certain financial conditions exist, etc. Amends Ch. 378, 211.3103, 403.4154, 4155. Appropriation. Effective Date: 11/12/2003.

Biomedical Research Trust Fund; re-creates Biomedical Research Trust Fund within Health Dept. without modification; carries forward current balances & continues current sources & uses thereof; abrogates provisions re termination of trust fund, to conform. Repeals 20.435(1)(h)3. Effective Date: 07/01/2004.

Education Finance Program through partial reduction of tax credits for contributions to nonprofit scholarship–funding organizations based on estimated student enrollment; specifies total amount of tax credits & carryforward tax credits that may be granted for 2003–2004 fiscal year; provides for allocation of appropriation for 2003–2004 fiscal year. Appropriation: \$38,000,000. Effective Date: 11/12/2003.
