26          Sr., Highway, and Ms. Barbara Van Blake Parkway

27          in Duval County; designating Ms. MaVynee "The

28          Beach Lady" Betsch Highway in Nassau County;

29          designating Brian D. Little Road in Okaloosa

30          County; designating John Land Apopka Expressway

31          in Orange County; designating the replacement

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1 bridge over Lake Jesup on State Road 46 near  
 2 Sanford as the "George C. Means Memorial  
 3 Bridge"; designating a portion of State Road  
 4 520 in Brevard County as the "Patrick D. Smith  
 5 Causeway"; designating the Charles M. Parker  
 6 Bridge in Bay County; designating Rosa Parks  
 7 Memorial Highway in Alachua and Marion  
 8 Counties; directing the Department of  
 9 Transportation to erect suitable markers;  
 10 designating the Austin Dewey Gay Memorial  
 11 Agricultural Inspection Station in Escambia  
 12 County; directing the Department of Agriculture  
 13 and Consumer Services to erect markers;  
 14 providing an effective date.

16 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

17  
18 Section 1. Osun's Village designated; Department of  
19 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

20 (1) That portion of N.W. 7th Avenue between N.W. 54th  
21 Street and N.W. 60th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated  
22 as "Osun's Village."

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
24 erect suitable markers designating Osun's Village as described  
25 in subsection (1).

26 Section 2. African Caribbean Cultural Arts Corridor  
27 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
28 markers.--

29 (1) That portion of N.W. 7th Avenue between N.W. 36th  
30 Street and N.W. 79th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated  
31 as "African Caribbean Cultural Arts Corridor."

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1           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
2 erect suitable markers designating African Caribbean Cultural  
3 Arts Corridor as described in subsection (1).

4           Section 3. Burl Marler Walkway designated; Department  
5 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

6           (1) The pedestrian overpass on John Sims Parkway in  
7 the City of Niceville in Okaloosa County is designated as  
8 "Burl Marler Walkway."

9           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
10 erect suitable markers designating Burl Marler Walkway as  
11 described in subsection (1).

12           Section 4. Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge designated;  
13 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

14           (1) The Cervantes Street Bridge on U.S. Highway 90  
15 over Bayou Texar in the City of Pensacola in Escambia County  
16 is designated as "Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge."

17           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
18 erect suitable markers designating Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge  
19 as described in subsection (1).

20           Section 5. Carlos C. Lopez-Aguilar Way designated;  
21 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

22           (1) That portion of S.W. 1st Street between 8th Avenue  
23 and 12th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Carlos  
24 C. Lopez-Aguilar Way."

25           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
26 erect suitable markers designating Carlos C. Lopez-Aguilar Way  
27 as described in subsection (1).

28           Section 6. Reverend Samuel Atchison Boulevard  
29 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
30 markers.--

31           (1) That portion of N.W. 7th Avenue between N.W. 62nd

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1 Street and N.W. 95th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated  
2 as "Reverend Samuel Atchison Boulevard."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating Reverend Samuel Atchison  
5 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 7. Adam Leigh Cann Building designated;  
7 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

8 (1) That portion of the Department of Transportation  
9 District Six Headquarters commonly known as the Main Building,  
10 which is located at 1000 N.W. 111th Avenue in the City of  
11 Miami, is designated as the "Adam Leigh Cann Building."

12 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
13 erect suitable markers designating the Adam Leigh Cann  
14 Building as described in subsection (1).

15 Section 8. Senator N. Ray Carroll Memorial Interchange  
16 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
17 markers.--

18 (1) The Florida Turnpike interchange being constructed  
19 at Milepost 240 and Kissimmee Park Road in Osceola County is  
20 designated as "Senator N. Ray Carroll Memorial Interchange."

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
22 erect suitable markers designating Senator N. Ray Carroll  
23 Memorial Interchange as described in subsection (1).

24 Section 9. Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard  
25 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
26 markers; repeal of prior designation.--

27 (1) That portion of State Road 944 on N.W. 54th Street  
28 between U.S. Highway 1 and N.E. 2nd Avenue in Miami-Dade  
29 County is designated as "Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard."

30 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
31 erect suitable markers designating Toussaint L'Ouverture

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1 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

2 (3) Section 6 of chapter 2003-296, Laws of Florida, is  
3 repealed.

4 Section 10. Reverend Gerard Jean-Juste Boulevard  
5 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
6 markers.--

7 (1) That portion of State Road 944 on N.W. 54th Street  
8 between N.E. 2nd Avenue and N.W. 7th Avenue in Miami-Dade  
9 County is designated as "Reverend Gerard Jean-Juste  
10 Boulevard."

11 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
12 erect suitable markers designating Reverend Gerard Jean-Juste  
13 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

14 Section 11. A.B. Martin Street designated;  
15 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

16 (1) That portion of N.W. 135th Street between N.W.  
17 27th Avenue and N.W. 37th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is  
18 designated as "A.B. Martin Street."

19 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
20 erect suitable markers designating A.B. Martin Street as  
21 described in subsection (1).

22 Section 12. Leighton Lee Baker Memorial Highway  
23 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
24 markers.--

25 (1) That portion of Old U.S. Highway 441 between David  
26 Walker Drive and Eudora Road in Lake County is designated as  
27 "Leighton Lee Baker Memorial Highway."

28 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
29 erect suitable markers designating Leighton Lee Baker Memorial  
30 Highway as described in subsection (1).

31 Section 13. Trinchi Boulevard designated; Department

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1 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

2 (1) That portion of S.W. 10th Street between F.A.U.  
3 Research Park Boulevard and the Sawgrass Expressway in the  
4 City of Deerfield Beach in Broward County is designated as  
5 "Trinchi Boulevard."

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
7 erect suitable markers designating Trinchi Boulevard as  
8 described in subsection (1).

9 Section 14. John Van Waters Memorial Highway  
10 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
11 markers.--

12 (1) That portion of State Road 35 from County Road 35A  
13 north to the Pasco County line in Pasco County is designated  
14 as "John Van Waters Memorial Highway."

15 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
16 erect suitable markers designating John Van Waters Memorial  
17 Highway as described in subsection (1).

18 Section 15. Dr. Emilio Ochoa Boulevard designated;  
19 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

20 (1) That portion of Calle Ocho (S.W. 8th Street)  
21 between S.W. 87th Avenue and S.W. 97th Avenue in Miami-Dade  
22 County is designated as "Dr. Emilio Ochoa Boulevard."

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
24 erect suitable markers designating Dr. Emilio Ochoa Boulevard  
25 as described in subsection (1).

26 Section 16. Ms. Eddie Mae Steward Avenue designated;  
27 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

28 (1) That portion of Main Street between West 6th  
29 Street and West 8th Street in Duval County is designated as  
30 "Ms. Eddie Mae Steward Avenue."

31 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to

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1 erect suitable markers designating Ms. Eddie Mae Steward  
2 Avenue as described in subsection (1).

3 Section 17. Dr. Mary L. Austin Jones Avenue  
4 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
5 markers.--

6 (1) That portion of Main Street between West 37th  
7 Street and West 46th Street in Duval County is designated as  
8 "Dr. Mary L. Austin Jones Avenue."

9 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
10 erect suitable markers designating Dr. Mary L. Austin Jones  
11 Avenue as described in subsection (1).

12 Section 18. Mrs. Flossie Brunson Avenue designated;  
13 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

14 (1) That portion of Main Street between West 8th  
15 Street and West 18th Street in Duval County is designated as  
16 "Mrs. Flossie Brunson Avenue."

17 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
18 erect suitable markers designating Mrs. Flossie Brunson Avenue  
19 as described in subsection (1).

20 Section 19. Dr. Robert L. Brown, Sr., Highway  
21 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
22 markers.--

23 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 1 between Finch  
24 Avenue and Trout River Boulevard in Duval County is designated  
25 as "Dr. Robert L. Brown, Sr., Highway."

26 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
27 erect suitable markers designating Dr. Robert L. Brown, Sr.,  
28 Highway as described in subsection (1).

29 Section 20. Ms. Barbara Van Blake Parkway designated;  
30 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

31 (1) That portion of Lem Turner Road between Interstate

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1 95 and Edgewood Avenue in Duval County is designated as " Ms.  
2 Barbara Van Blake Parkway."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating Ms. Barbara Van Blake  
5 Parkway as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 21. Ms. MaVynee "The Beach Lady" Betsch  
7 Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect  
8 suitable markers.--

9 (1) That portion of Florida First Coast Highway  
10 beginning at Burney Road and continuing north through the 5500  
11 block of Florida First Coast Highway in Nassau County is  
12 designated as "Ms. MaVynee 'The Beach Lady' Betsch Highway."

13 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
14 erect suitable markers designating Ms. MaVynee "The Beach  
15 Lady" Betsch Highway as described in subsection (1).

16 Section 22. Brian D. Little Road designated;  
17 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

18 (1) That portion of State Road 188 between State Road  
19 189 and State Road 85 in Okaloosa County is designated as  
20 "Brian D. Little Road."

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
22 erect suitable markers designating Brian D. Little Road as  
23 described in subsection (1).

24 Section 23. John Land Apopka Expressway designated;  
25 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

26 (1) That portion of State Road 414 known as Maitland  
27 Boulevard that extends west from U.S. Highway 441 to the City  
28 of Apopka before heading north to U.S. Highway 441 near County  
29 Road 437, which is commonly known as Maitland Boulevard  
30 Extension, is designated as "John Land Apopka Expressway."

31 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to

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1 erect suitable markers designating John Land Apopka Expressway  
2 as described in subsection (1).

3       Section 24. George C. Means Memorial Bridge  
4 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
5 markers.--

6       (1) The replacement bridge over Lake Jesup on State  
7 Road 46 near Sanford designated as the "George C. Means  
8 Memorial Bridge."

9       (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
10 erect suitable markers designating the George C. Means  
11 Memorial Bridge as described in subsection (1).

12       Section 25. Patrick D. Smith Causeway designated;  
13 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

14       (1) The portion of State Road 520 in Brevard County  
15 which is between mile post 13.2 and mile post 15.3 and lies  
16 approximately between the West Banana River and Cape Canaveral  
17 Hospital is designated as the "Patrick D. Smith Causeway."

18       (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
19 erect suitable markers designating the Patrick D. Smith  
20 Causeway as described in subsection (1).

21       Section 26. Charles M. Parker Bridge designated;  
22 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

23       (1) The Canal Park Bridge on U.S. Highway 98 in the  
24 City of Mexico Beach in Bay County is designated as the  
25 "Charles M. Parker Bridge."

26       (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
27 erect suitable markers designating the Charles M. Parker  
28 Bridge as described in subsection (1).

29       Section 27. Rosa Parks Memorial Highway designated;  
30 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

31       (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 301 from State Road

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1 40 in Marion County through the City of Waldo in Alachua  
2 County is designated as "Rosa Parks Memorial Highway."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating Rosa Parks Memorial Highway  
5 as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 28. Austin Dewey Gay Memorial Agricultural  
7 Inspection Station designated; Department of Agriculture and  
8 Consumer Services to erect suitable markers.--

9 (1) The inspection station of the Department of  
10 Agriculture and Consumer Services which is located at the  
11 1-mile marker on Interstate Highway 10 in Escambia County is  
12 designated as the "Austin Dewey Gay Memorial Agricultural  
13 Inspection Station."

14 (2) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer  
15 Services is directed to erect suitable markers designating the  
16 Austin Dewey Gay Memorial Agricultural Inspection Station as  
17 described in subsection (1).

18 Section 29. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

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
