BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR FOR THURSDAY, JANUARY 18, 2007

CS/HB 1-A (SO) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representatives Rivera, Grimsley, Seiler and A. Gibson—

Hurricane Preparedness & Insurance; cites act as "Insurance Industry Accountability & Consumer Protection Act"; prohibits certain insurers from transacting residential property insurance business under certain circumstances; revises capitalization requirements for insurers writing property insurance; provides legislative intent re savings to customers for windstorm mitigation efforts; provides prohibition & requirements for insurers in denying coverage, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

CS/CS/HB 3-A (SO) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representatives Kravitz, Seiler, Taylor and others—

Hurricane Preparedness & Insurance; cites act as "Homeowners' Rate Reduction Act"; deletes rapid cash buildup requirement from reimbursement premium formula factor; provides for temporary emergency options for additional coverage & for temporary increase in coverage limit options; requires insurers electing optional coverages offered by Fla. Hurricane Catastrophe Fund to make rate filings that reflect savings or reduction in loss exposure, etc. Amends 215.555. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

CS/CS/HB 5-A (SO) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Economic Expansion & Infrastructure Council, Representatives Traviesa, Sands and others—

Hurricane Preparedness & Insurance; cites act as "Home Enhancement & Loss Prevention Act"; revises criteria for wind certification & hurricane mitigation inspectors; revises certain financial wind certification & mitigation grant criteria & use provisions; creates Windstorm Mitigation Study Committee for purpose of analyzing solutions & programs that could address state's need to mitigate effects of windstorms on structures, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

HB 7-A (SO) by Representatives Coley, Richardson and others—

Building Code Hurricane Preparedness; cites act as "Uniform Building Code Act"; provides intent re effect of building code modifications on wind protection; requires uniform application of certain standards re wind-borne debris & structural guidelines; prohibits code modification that diminishes construction requirements; prescribes date by which counties & municipalities must enforce certain windborne debris protections & structural guidelines, etc. Amends 553.73. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

CS/HB 9-A (SO) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representatives Bogdanoff, Long and others—

Hurricane Preparedness & Insurance; cites act as "Citizens Reform & Private Market Restoration Act"; amends provision re Fla. Interlocal Cooperation Act; authorizes certain hospitals & hospital systems to pool & spread windstorm property exposure risk among members; provides criteria for participation; revises criteria & requirements for levy of emergency assessments by Fla. Insurance Guarantee Assoc., etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.


