## BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

### SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR FOR FRIDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2007

#### **SB 2-C (SO) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Calendar Committee (Carlton)—**

**Special Appropriations;** Provides appropriations and reductions in appropriations for the 2007-2008 fiscal year, to pay salaries, and other expenses, capital outlay - buildings, and other improvements, and for other specified purposes of the various agencies of state government, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

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#### **SB 4-C (SO) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Calendar Committee (Carlton)—**

**Special Appropriations Implementing Bill;** Requires state agencies to submit to the Executive Office of the Governor requests for revisions, additions, or deletions to approved performance measures and standards related to implementing the reductions and other changes in appropriations for the 2007-2008 fiscal year, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

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#### **CS/SB 20-C (SO) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—**

**Research Funded by Pari-mutuel Wagering;** Repeals a provision relating to research and development programs funded by moneys in the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Committee on General Government Appropriations*

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#### **CS/SB 22-C (SO) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—**

**Adjustments to Appropriations for DOACS;** Increases the annual fees to register each brand of pesticide in order to defray the expenses of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (DOACS). Increases the fee to accompany an application for a food permit to be issued by DOACS. Increases the fee paid by persons receiving a license to distribute fertilizer. Requires that all female cattle vaccinated with the Brucella abortus vaccine be identified according to federal regulations, etc. Effective Date: 11/01/2007 or upon becoming law, whichever occurs later.

Committee on General Government Appropriations*

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#### **CS/SB 24-C (SO) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—**

**Trust Funds/DEP/FWC;** Revises the amount of revenue from the excise tax which is deposited into the Water Protection and Sustainability Program TF, the Conservation and Recreation Lands TF, and the Invasive Plant Control TF in DEP and the State Game TF and the Marine Resources Conservation TF in the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. Repeals provisions relating to the use of funds distributed from the Marine Resources Conservation TF, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the  
Committee on General Government Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 16-C (SO) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Motor Vehicles/Property Damage Liability Coverage;** Requires each person operating a motor vehicle to have in his or her possession proof of property damage liability coverage. Clarifies the requirements concerning insurance and liability coverage for certain motor vehicles registered in this state. Provides that this act does not reenact any provision of the Florida Motor Vehicle No-Fault Law, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 12-C (SO) by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations and Senator Peaden—**

**Health Care;** Provides for additional hours to be authorized under the personal care assistance services provided pursuant to a federal waiver program and administered by the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA). Provides for certain children who are eligible for Medicaid and who reside within a specified service area of the AHCA to be served under a service delivery mechanism other than the HomeSafeNet System, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 14-C (SO) by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations and Senator Peaden—**

**Byrd/Alzheimer's Center & Research Institute;** Reduces the annual appropriation to the Grants and Donations Trust Fund within the Department of Elderly Affairs for the purpose of conducting research and carrying on other activities at the Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 6-C (SO) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations and Senator Wise—**

**Adjustments to Education Appropriations/Pre K-12;** Authorizes the Education Commissioner to recommend a reduction in the amount transferred to a school district's fixed capital outlay fund based on the reduction in the district's allocation for its class size operating categorical. Provides for a district school board to transfer certain categorical funds for academic classroom instruction. Requires DOE to report to the Legislature the amounts transferred, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 8-C (SO) by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations and Senator Lynn—**

**Tuition and Fees for Higher Education;** Deletes provisions requiring the State Board of Education to adopt a fee schedule. Provides standard resident tuition for the career certificate, applied technology diploma, and adult general education courses. Provides standard resident and nonresident tuition and fees for community college programs. Deletes provisions requiring the State Board of Education to adopt the fee schedule in the absence of a provision in an appropriations act, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations*

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**CS/SB 10-C (SO) by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations and Senator Lynn—**

**Higher Education/Bright Futures/Academic Scholars;** Revises the eligibility requirements for the Fla. Bright Futures Scholarship Program. Provides for the disbursement of funds under the program to students enrolled in the early admission program during the 2007-2008 second semester. Requires that the amount awarded to Florida Academic Scholars for college-related expenses be specified by law or in the General Appropriations Act, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations*

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**SB 44-C (SO) by Senator Diaz de la Portilla—**

**Property Taxes/Municipalities;** Changes the time a municipality must have been in a state of financial emergency to be considered a municipality of special financial concern. Declares certain municipalities to be in violation of certain maximum millage limitation provisions under certain circumstances. Requires certain noncomplying municipalities to forfeit local government half-cent sales tax distributions under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Finance and Tax*

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**CS/SB 40-C (SO) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Posey and others—**

**Motor Vehicle Insurance;** Requires each person operating a motor vehicle to have in his or her possession proof of property damage liability coverage. Requires insurers to report to HSMV the renewal, cancellation, or nonrenewal of a policy providing PIP coverage or motor vehicle property damage liability coverage. Revives, reenacts, and amends the Florida Motor Vehicle No-Fault Law, notwithstanding the repeal of such law provided in s. 19, Ch. 2003-411, Laws of Florida, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance*

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**CS/SB 42-C (SO) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance Senator Posey—**

**Pub. Rec./Motor Vehicle Insurance;** Creates a public-records exemption for certain information held by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles which concerns a person insured or formerly insured by a personal injury protection or property damage liability insurance policy. Provides for retroactive application of the exemption. Provides for future review and repeal of the exemption under the OGSR Act. Provides a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: Contingent.

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
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
