Your Conference Committee on the disagreeing votes of the two houses on HB 5067, same being:


An act relating to **state infrastructure**; removing the DUI Programs Coordination Trust Fund from the list of funds invested by the Chief Financial Officer; reenacting and amending s. 20.24, F.S., relating to the establishment of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Government Accountability Act; removing a provision for the Bureau of Motor Vehicle Inspection; removing the DUI Programs Coordination Trust Fund from the list of funds subject to a specified service charge; revising provisions for a surcharge on certain insurance policies; removing a provision directing the proceeds of the surcharge be deposited into the Emergency Management, Preparedness, and Assistance Trust Fund; revising provisions for certain procurement procedures developed by the Department of Community Affairs for eligible local governments under the Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program; providing that such procurement procedures may not exceed specified federal requirements; conforming a cross-reference to changes made by the act; revising the amount of a penalty for failure to pay specified penalties for certain traffic infractions; providing for distribution of the increased amount collected; defining the term "certificate of title"; defining the term "certificate of title"; authorizing the issuance of electronic motor vehicle titles in lieu of paper motor vehicle titles; authorizing the department to collect and use e-mail addresses of motor vehicle owners and registrants as a notification method; removing a requirement for a motorcycle endorsement at the time of original registration of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, or moped; providing for distribution of certain moneys collected relating to registration of motor vehicles and mobile homes; revises uses of certain motorcycle and moped license tax fees; providing for disposition of certain specialty license plate processing fees; amending s. 320.203, F.S., relating to disposition of biennial license tax moneys; conforming provisions to changes made by the act; authorizing the department to collect and use e-mail addresses of motor vehicle owners and registrants as a notification method; defining the term "convenience service" for purposes of transactions with the department; revising the definition of the term "conviction" to provide for application to offenses committed by a person holding a commercial driver's license; revising the definition of the terms "hazardous materials" and "out-of-service order"; revising provisions for funding of certain driver improvement programs;


eliminating requirements for motorcycle safety education course reimbursements; removing provisions for issuance of a license valid in Florida only; prohibiting a person from holding more than one driver's license; authorizing use of such licenses until next renewal; revising requirements for application for issuance or renewal of an identification card; revising provisions providing for the expiration of an identification card issued by the department; revising requirements for application for a driver's license; removing a provision requiring the application form to include language permitting a voluntary contribution for the Election Campaign Financing Trust Fund; revising provisions for content of a driver's license; requiring the license to contain the licensee's residence address; removing a requirement that the license contain the licensee's mailing address; authorizing a law enforcement officer or authorized representative of the department to collect a person's fingerprints electronically; revising the requirements for obtaining a replacement license or permit; deleting provisions authorizing the department to issue address stickers; revising provisions providing for the expiration and renewal of driver's licenses; providing for the renewal of certain licenses every 8 years; conforming cross-references; providing for the renewal of licenses using a convenience service; requiring the department to issue new licenses rather than extension stickers; repealing s. 322.181, F.S., relating to a study of effects of aging on driving ability; eliminating the Florida At-Risk Driver Council; revising provisions for a licensee changing address; removing a provision for the licensee to request a change-of-address sticker; conforming cross-references; increasing the service fees for reinstating a suspended or revoked driver's license or commercial motor vehicle license; revising provisions for distribution and use of the funds received; authorizing the department to waive the hearing process for a person whose license has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked; providing exceptions; requiring that DUI programs be administered by the department and paid for by revenues collected by such programs; providing that such revenues be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund; authorizing the use of electronic mail for distribution of vessel titles; authorizing the department to collect and use e-mail addresses of vessel owners and registrants as a notification method; authorizing the department to accept certain applications by electronic or telephonic means; authorizing the department to collect and use e-mail addresses of vessel owners and registrants as a notification method; revising duties of the Department of Transportation; revising certain roadside beautification provisions; providing contract bid requirements for fuel and food on the turnpike system; providing for use of transportation revenues; providing for revised funding levels for Department of Transportation projects; conforming cross-references to changes made by the act; authorizing the Building Code Commission to utilize communications media technology to conduct meetings; conforming a cross-reference.


having met, and after full and free conference, do recommend to their respective houses as follows:
