

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 138 Imitation Firearms by Senator Wilson

Prohibits the sale of imitation firearms except for certain purposes. Provides that a person who sales, or offers for sale, an imitation firearm in this state commits a first degree misdemeanor and that any subsequent violation is a third degree felony. Defines "imitation firearm" as any toy gun, replica of a firearm, air-soft gun that fires nonmetallic projectiles, or other device that is so substantially similar in color and appearance to a statutorily defined firearm that a reasonable person would be lead to believe that the device is a firearm. Provides specific exceptions with regard to federal regulations governing imitation firearms. (See bill for details)
