SB 186

University of South Florida Lakeland
by Senator Alexander

Establishes the University of South Florida Lakeland campus to be operated as a separate organizational and budget entity of the University of South Florida (USF) and to operate under separate accreditation when in the best interest of the campus. Provides for a Campus Board. Provides for administration by a Campus Executive Officer who shall be appointed by, report directly to, and serve at the pleasure of the President of USF. Provides that students enrolled at USF and branch campuses have the same rights and obligations. Requires the university to provide a system for students enrolled at any USF campus to register for courses at any other USF campus. (See bill for details)
