

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 390 Controlled Substances by Senator Oelrich

Prohibits owning, leasing, renting, or possessing a place, structure, trailer, or other described place with knowledge that it will be used to manufacture, sell, or traffic in a controlled substance. Provides that possession of 25 or more cannabis plants constitutes prima facie evidence of intent to sell or distribute. Provides that a person possessing a place or conveyance used to manufacture a controlled substance for sale and distribution commits a felony of the first degree if a minor is present or resides there. Provides that a person who allows an infant or toddler to be in close proximity to a controlled substance commits a felony of the first degree. Provides that equipment used in the cultivation or manufacture of controlled substances may be photographed or video recorded and the photograph or video recording used as evidence for later use at trial. Provides for destruction of the equipment. (See bill for details)
