SB 456

Ignition Interlock Device/Driving Under the Influence by Senator Wise

Requires that an ignition interlock device be installed for 6 months for a first conviction of driving under the influence if the person had an alcohol level of 0.15 or higher but less than 0.20 at the time of the offense. Requires installation of such device for at least 1 year for a second conviction. (See bill for details)
