

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 510 School-entry/Vision Examinations by Senator Wilson

Requires that children who are entering school present evidence of having received a comprehensive vision examination which was performed within one year of their enrollment in school. Allows each district school board, and the governing authority of each private school, to establish a policy that permits a student up to 120 school days to present a certification of the vision exam. Imposes a 25-cent fee on the retail sale of nonprescription eyeglasses to assist parents in need of financial assistance to pay for the vision exam. (See bill for details)
