

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 540 Felons/Enforcement of Federal Immigration Laws by Senator Baker

Requires law enforcement officers, sheriffs, chief correctional officers, and clerks of the circuit court to report to Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the United States Department of Homeland Security suspected illegal aliens who are arrested, detained, or convicted of a felony.

Requires law enforcement agencies to provide written notice to each law enforcement officer of the officer's duty to cooperate with federal officials with regard to enforcing federal immigration laws.

Requires the Office of the Attorney General, the Department of Law Enforcement, and all state and local law enforcement agencies to pursue opportunities to collect federal funds for the reimbursement of moneys spent to enforce federal immigration laws. (See bill for details)
