SB 694

Caller ID Anti-spoofing Act by Senator Aronberg

Prohibits entering false information into a telephone caller identification system with the intent to deceive, defraud, or mislead. Prohibits placing a call knowing that false information was entered into such system. Provides exceptions to such requirements for the blocking of caller identification information of any federal, state, county, or municipal government law enforcement agency, and any federal intelligence or security agency.

Provides that a violation of the Caller ID Anti-spoofing Act is a first degree misdemeanor. Provides that a felony or misdemeanor degree shall be reclassified to the next higher degree when a violation of the act occurs during the commission of any criminal offense, or if violation of the act facilitated or furthered such offense. Provides that any violation of the act constitutes an unlawful trade practice under the Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices law and such violations are subject to any remedies or penalties provided for under such law.
