SB 754

Hurricane Preparedness and Insurance by Senator Baker

Creates the Citizens Property Insurance Corporation (CPIC) Mission Review Task Force to analyze and compile data and to develop a report setting forth the statutory and operational changes relating to the CPIC.

Requires the Chief Financial Officer to provide a report on the economic impact on the state of a 1-in-250-year hurricane by March 1 of each year.

Limits the authority of the Florida Building Commission (FBC) to modify codes and standards relating to wind protection. Requires counties and municipalities to enforce certain windborne debris protections and structural guidelines adopted by the American Society of Civil Engineers.

Revises reporting requirements for the FBC's voluntary "Code Plus" guidelines. Provides an appropriation. (See bill for details)
