

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 802 Motorcycles or Mopeds/Reckless Driving by Senator Garcia

Provides that if a person is operating or is in actual physical control of a motorcycle while driving recklessly, a law enforcement officer shall arrest the person, take him or her into custody, and seize the motorcycle. Requires that the court shall, upon conviction, revoke the authorization and privilege to operate a motorcycle for a period of 10 years.

Requires that a person riding on a motorcycle or moped must ride while sitting astride the seat with one leg on each side and with both wheels on the ground at all times. Requires the license tag to be permanently affixed horizontally to the ground and may not be adjusted or capable of being flipped up. (See bill for details)
