

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 814 DNA Testing of Arrested Persons by Senator Lynn

Requires that persons who are arrested for any offense or attempted offense including, but not limited to, sexual battery, lewdness, indecent exposure, murder, aggravated battery, or burglary to undergo blood or other biological specimen testing for DNA analysis. Requires that the arresting agency secure and transmit the blood or other biological specimens to the Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE). Provides that a medical institution and medical personnel authorized to draw blood are not civilly or criminally liable as a result of withdrawing blood specimens as required by the act. Authorizes the FDLE, a state attorney, or any law enforcement agency to apply to the circuit court for an order to take the person into custody if the person fails to provide the required specimens. Requires that a nonindigent arrested person pay the costs of collecting the blood or other biological specimen. (See bill for details)
