

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 984 Motor Fuels Taxes by Senator Bennett

Authorizes counties to adopt an ordinance adjusting the rate of the ninth-cent fuel tax or the local option fuel tax based on the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index. Requires each imposition or rate change of the tax to be levied before July 1 in order to be effective January 1 of the following year. Requires that the county furnish a copy of the ordinance to the Department of Revenue (DOR). Requires the DOR to notify each terminal supplier, position holder, wholesaler, and importer of the tax rate that is applicable for the 12-month period beginning January 1. (See bill for details)
