### Transitional Services/Young Adults with Disabilities by Senator Wise

Creates the Health Care Transition Services Task Force for Youth and Young Adults with Disabilities within the Department of Health to assess the need for health care transition services for youth with disabilities, develop strategies to ensure a successful transition from the pediatric to the adult health care system, and identify existing and potential funding sources.

Creates the Don Davis Health and Transition Services Program of Jacksonville to provide services for persons who are 14 through 26 years of age residing in Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau, and St. Johns counties, and who have chronic special health care needs or developmental disabilities. Describes participating service providers and the services that they are to provide. Provides an appropriation. (See bill for details)
